Guidelines and Scholarship Application

- The Dede Emerson Foundation Scholarship Program was established to give scholarships to deserving high school students seeking a higher education.
- 2. Scholarships are awarded for undergraduate full- or part-time study preferably in veterinary work or international affairs.
- 3. The amount of the scholarship is \$1,000 given once a year to any one student. Said amount will normally be given to the Board of Education for redistribution to the college on behalf of the recipient in the following manner: 50% (fifty percent) upon entry to college and 50% (fifty percent) upon achievement of satisfactory grades, defined C or above.
- 4. All applicants must be officially accepted into an accredited school in the United States and in need of financial assistance. The Scholarship Committee shall determine said need.
- 5. Applicants must reside in the Greater Grand Rapids, Minnesota, school district.
- The scholarship does not cover study at the masters or doctoral level or correspondence courses.
- 7. The Scholarship Committee shall consist of two or three representatives from the Dede Emerson Foundation plus two or three representatives chosen by the Board of Education.
- 8. The Scholarship Committee will meet during May to make its selection; therefore, the deadline for completed applications and all supporting materials is May 1°. No fax applications will be accepted.
- 9. Primary criteria for the scholarship is demonstrated scholastic ability and financial need.
- 10.Prospective applicants will be contacted by the Scholarship Committee for an interview if necessary.
- 11. Applications are available through the Grand Rapids High School counselors' office.
