Foundation Conference: The annual Dysferlin Conference brings together scientists and clinicians working to understand and develop a therapy for the dysferlinopathies, Limb Girdle Muscular Dystrophy 2B (LGMD2B) and Miyoshi Myopathy. These diseases, caused by mutations in dysferlin, are characterized by progressive muscle wasting beginning in the late teenage years. Although dysferlin has been implicated in repair of muscle fiber membrane tears, a more complete understanding of dysferlin's function and role in pathology is required for effective development of therapies. The objective of the 4th Annual Dysferlin Conference, held from September 11-14, 2010 in Bellevue, WA, USA, was to speed research on dysferlinopathy by promoting the sharing of ideas and unpublished data between scientists actively working on dysferlin and other relevant therapeutic approaches. The meeting implemented a novel conference format with an informal lab-meeting atmosphere to encourage the open exchange of information that typically exists within individual laboratories, as well as a unique agenda in which speakers presented individual scientific results, rather than full-length presentations, in relevant topic-oriented sessions to ensure a more logical flow of information and discussions. The conference was sponsored and organized by the Jain Foundation, and participants included 36 invited speakers, 16 additional scientists and clinicians, 26 poster presenters, 4 dysferlinopathy patients, 2 representatives of other muscular dystrophy foundations, and 7 members of the Jain Foundation

Research Resources: One goal of the Jain Foundation is to promote cross-collaboration between scientists and labs along many different research lines. The Foundation encourages labs to share ideas and collaborate in order to improve the quality of research results and reduce the costs and time of experiments. Two initiatives in this regard have been the establishment and maintenance of a Researcher Forum and the development of the Resources for Researchers, both of which are accessible on the Foundation's website.

The Researcher forum: This is a sounding board for scientific ideas and results specific to LGMD2B with other members of the scientific community. It forms bridges between scientists and acts as a catalyst to new and creative approaches and discussions on this rare disease. Additionally, the Foundation launched the Jain Foundation Resource Sharing Network on the Foundation's website in 2008. This network is a private community where scientists search for lab resources such as reagents, cell lines, animal models, protocols, facilities/equipment, and expertise developed by other scientists to facilitate research on dysferlin and LGMD2B/MM. This will further expedite the exchange of resources between the scientists.

Resources for Researchers: The Foundation reviews and summarizes research worldwide and makes these reviews available on the website as a database of specific and pertinent information. Having complex information and scientific results synthesized in an easy to navigate manner increases efficiency of all projects. The Foundation is committed to developing and providing frequently required reagents, the unavailability of which slows down research. For example the Foundation designed and funded the generation of antibodies through a company (Epitomics Inc) and generated new mouse models at Jackson Laboratories.

While the focus of its funded research is LGMD2B, the resulting scientific advances and collaborations will also have a broader impact on human health through their relevance to other conditions, including muscle disorders in general, degenerative diseases of tissues other than muscle, and normal aging. Examples include those on stem cell therapy, gene therapy, editing within DNA and RNA, repair of cellular injury, and interventional membrane biology. The Foundation is very hands on in its approach to funding. We closely monitor progress of every project we fund (every month) and keep track of results and agreed upon timelines. Our goal is to fund all different but possible approaches to a cure.

Patient Identification and Registration: Given the relative rarity of \$ this disease, one of the goals of the Foundation is to identify a worldwide LGMD2B patient population. The Foundation maintains a patient registry and facilitates by providing funding for patients' diagnosis to the genetic and molecular level, which will greatly accelerate the process of patient recruitment for clinical trials.
