The exact amount will be determined on a year to year basis based on the earnings of the Trust and the rules and regulations of the Internal Revenue Service. ### II. The Randle Watts & Versa Watts Scholarship Criteria

Each year for the one student at Mayfield High School and the one student at Graves County High School, must meet the following requirements:

- (a) Must have resided in Graves County (which includes the City of Mayfield) for a continuous period of five years.
- (b) Must be a High School Senior.
- (c) Must have a minimum ACT score of 20.
- (d) Must plan to attend a Kentucky four year accredited college (regardless whether a private or public college).
- (e) Must agree to be a full time student at the four year Kentucky accredited college (earn at least 12 hours per semester or 24 hours per year).
- (f) Must maintain a college grade point average of at least 2.5 (based on a 4.0 scale) each semester or quarter.
- (g) Must submit a copy of his/her actual college transcript to James B. Brien, Jr., who is the Trustee, at the end of each semester. The Trustee will then review the actual college transcript to approve the recipient for future scholarship monies.
- (h) Must submit invoices for tuition, room or board directly to James B. Brien, Jr., who is the Trustee; he will approve/disapprove the invoice. If approved, notification will be given to the appropriate person in each school system. The school system then will make payments directly to the college or institution that the scholarship recipient is attending, as opposed to making payments directly to the recipient.

### III. Requirements that a Scholarship applicant must comply with:

The following must be in the office of the guidance counselor for the respective schools by March 30<sup>th</sup> of each and every year.

- 1. General Application Form
- 2. College Acceptance Data Form
- 3. Scholarship Acceptance Agreement Form
- 4. Three completed reference questionnaires (two from educators and one from a person not in education who has observed the students in activities such as sports, scouts, church, community work, extracurricular activities, etc.) These references should be sent directly to the guidance counselor or placed in a sealed envelope and given to the counselor.
- 5. Financial aid form provided in packet
- 6. High School Transcript
- 7. An essay outlining the student's career goals and educational goals. In the essay, the applicant should outline the reasons he/she thinks that the scholarship should be awarded to them.

Incomplete, late, or incorrectly submitted applications will not be considered by the Selection Committee. It is the student's responsibility to determine whether the application is complete.
