- Cost of the proposed project and the amount being sought from the Foundation.
- Budget for the proposed project.
- Organization's budget.
- A list of other sources of support and the amounts and types of their donations.
- An explanation of whether this is an ongoing activity or a one-time project.

Question 2d

The Foundation currently intends that its sole activity will be to make grants to other organizations which are exempt from taxation under Section 501(c)(3) in order to carry out the philanthropic objectives of Mutual of Omaha Insurance Company. Although there are no current plans to do so, the Foundation may also use its funds to engage directly in other 501(c)(3) exempt activities. The Foundation intends to focus its philanthropy in the Omaha community within the following areas:

- Supporting community wellness through support of programs that address issues of behavioral health, youth violence, domestic abuse and obesity in children.
- Supporting education by providing grants to organizations addressing early childhood education, preparedness for graduation, literacy and language proficiency and financial literacy.
- Supporting organizations whose primary mission is to address issues of homelessness and hunger.
