Part II, Question 9b - Previous Method Change

Under the automatic consent procedures in Rev. Proc. 2008-52, , the applicant changed its method of accounting used to regularly compute its income in keeping its books and records to the overall cash receipts and disbursements method for the year ended December 31, 2008 pursuant to Rev. Proc 2002-28. Pursuant Section 14.01(2) of the Appendix to Rev. Proc. 2011-52, the scope limitation in Rev. Proc. 2011-52, Section 4.02(6) is disregarded because the applicant changed in its overall method of accounting to the cash method pursuant to Rev. Proc 2002-28.

Part II, Question 13 - Description of Trade or Business

The Cox Employee Disaster Relief Fund, Inc. was organized on September 1, 2005 mainly in response to the needs of Hurricane Katrina victims, but the applicant's purposes are much broader than responding to a single disaster. The fundamental purpose of the applicant is to provide monetary and nonmonetary relief to victims of natural disasters, accidents, serious illness, or other emergency events. Benefits are provided principally to victims who are either employees or former employees of Cox Enterprises, Inc. and affiliates (CEI) and their family members. To achieve this purpose, the applicant collects contributions from CEI, its employees, vendors, shareholders, affiliates, and affiliates' employees, as well as the general public. Distributions are made directly to eligible individuals who demonstrate, according to established guidelines, that they have suffered losses as a result of a natural disaster, accident, illness, or other emergency that cannot be met by the individuals' own resources or via aid provided by federal, state, and local relief agencies. The applicant may also assist in organizing relief efforts, such as distributing supplies collected by the applicant or paying for cost of delivering supplies collected by the applicant.

Part IV, Question 25 - Computation of Section 481(a) Adjustment

The applicant has changed its overall method of accounting used to regularly compute its income in keeping its books and records to the accrual method. The accrual method more clearly reflects its income and provides better information to assist management in achieving the organization's goals and objectives.

The applicant's revenue increased significantly during 2010 due to several large contributions from certain community trusts. Due to the increase in revenues, the applicant intends to make investments to to earn additional income and thereby increase the applicant's ability to further its exempt purpose. The overall accrual method of accounting results in a clearer reflection of the applicant's revenues and investment income.

Under the applicant's proposed method of accounting and consistent with the overall accrual method of accounting, revenues are recorded as assets or receivables are exchanged, and expenses are recorded as liabilities are incurred.

The section 481(a) adjustment was computed by increasing income for receivables (revenue that has been earned, but not received and by decreasing income for accrued expenses (items that have not yet been

paid, but have been incurred). As of the beginning of the tax year, the applicant did not earn any revenue that had not been received, therefore an adjustment for receivables is 0.
