Narrative Description of Activities

The Cousins Properties Foundation (the "Foundation") was formed on December 23, 2005 as a Georgia non-profit corporation. The Foundation is a grant making organization that seeks to support qualified charitable organizations and initiatives that stabilize and sustain communities through social welfare programs. The Foundation intends to provide financial support to successful applicants, where applicants will be qualified 501(c)(3) organizations, except those organizations described in 509(a)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code. The Foundation is the product of the historical practice of charitable contributions by Cousins Properties Incorporated, a Georgia corporation, Cousins Real Estate Corporation, a Georgia corporation ("CREC") and their associated companies. It is intended that the Foundation will better organize the corporate practice of charitable contribution and will focus funds and energies on targeted efforts and issues.

The Foundation considers grant requests on a rolling basis throughout the fiscal year. Upon receipt of a grant application, the Foundation officers evaluate the grant requests and then review the request and evaluation with the President of the Foundation. The President of the Foundation then determines whether, when and how much to grant with respect to each request, taking into consideration the recommendation of the Foundation officers. Successful applicants will demonstrate substantive programming that improves the conditions and social welfare of the targeted communities. In addition, grant making criteria include demonstration that the activities selected for funding will result in a sustainable and measurable improvement in the target community. While unsolicited grants may be reviewed, the Foundation intends to focus its grant making on the Southeastern and Southwestern United States, but may make grants in other geographic areas. Since its formation, the Foundation has made grants to several 501(c)(3) organizations.

The Foundation is controlled by a board of directors designated by CREC. CREC is the sole contributor to the Foundation. The Foundation anticipates that CREC may make future grants to the Foundation. However, CREC is not obligated to make any future contributions, and the Foundation is not dependent upon any such future grants to pursue its mission. In addition, the Foundation does not intend to solicit or accept contributions from any other person.

The Foundation operates through the offices of CREC in Atlanta, Georgia. The officers of the Foundation are all also officers of CREC. The Foundation does not compensate or otherwise reimburse CREC for the cost of any service provided by the officers.
