## FIRST AMENDMENT TO THE TRUST KNOWN AS "THE TOPSY TURVY PRIVY FOUNDATION"

WHEREAS, under date of July 6, 2006, JAMES P. KEARNS (sometimes referred to herein as the "Settlor") executed a trust as Settlor, known as "THE TOPSY TURVY PRIVY FOUNDATION", of which JAMES P. KEARNS, EDWARD ROSSI, and AMY B. SCHNEIDER acted as Trustee ("the Trust"); and

WHEREAS, JAMES P. KEARNS under section 3.5 C of the Trust retains the right to amend the Trust "whenever the Trustees deem such action advisable for the more efficient administration of the Foundation or to enable the purposes of the Foundation to be accomplished more effectively" and the Settlor and the Trustees now desire to do so; and

WHEREAS, the Trust has been classified by the Internal Revenue Service as a private foundation under the Internal Revenue Code; and

WHEREAS, it was the overriding purpose of the Trust to create a taxexempt charitable trust distributions from which could be made only to charitable organizations that are exempt from income tax and which use such distributions only for charitable purposes; and

WHEREAS, the Settlor and the Trustees wish to confirm such intention by modifying the definitions of "Charitable Organization" and "Charitable Purpose" contained in the Trust to ensure that distributions may be made to any organization exempt from income tax and contributions to which are deductible for income tax purposes under the Internal Revenue Code.

NOW THEREFORE, in accordance with the powers reserved to the Settlor and the Trustees in the Trust, the Trust is hereby amended as follows:

### FIRST

The Settlor deletes section 1.3 of the Trust and substitutes a new section as follows:

### "1.3 Overriding Purpose

"In creating the Foundation, the overriding purpose of the Settlor is to form a charitable trust that is tax exempt under Internal Revenue Code section 501(c)(3) (hereinafter referred to as the "Code"), and contributions to which are deductible under Code sections 170, 2055 and 2522. It is the intention of the Settlor that the Foundation shall be fully exempt for purposes of United States and California income tax, gift tax, estate tax, and generation-skipping transfer tax. The property belonging to the Foundation shall be distributed only to tax-exempt Charitable Organizations for their Charitable Purposes, as defined below. Therefore, each provision of this Trust Agreement is to be interpreted so as to achieve this overriding purpose."

### SECOND:

The Settlor deletes section 1.4 of the Trust and substitutes a new section as follows:

### "1.4 Definitions

"The following definitions apply in this Trust Agreement.

- "A. Charitable Organization. The phrase "Charitable Organization" means an organization that is, at the time of a distribution to it, described in Code sections 170(c), 2055(a), and 2522(a), or in the corresponding provisions of any later federal tax laws.
- "B. Charitable Purposes. The phrase "Charitable Purposes" shall mean any allowable purpose under Code section 170(c), or in the corresponding provisions of any later federal tax laws."

#### THIRD:

In all other respects the Settlor confirms and republishes the Trust.

This Amendment shall be effective as of the date of the last signature of the Settlor and the Trustees.
