### 1. Organization and Summary of Significant Accounting Policies

### Organization

The Atlantic Foundation (the "Foundation") was incorporated under the laws of the State of New Jersey as a private foundation.

The Foundation was established for charitable, religious, scientific, literary or educational purposes either directly or by contributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code.

### **Basis of Accounting**

The accompanying financial statements of the Foundation have been prepared on the accrual basis of accounting and accordingly reflect all significant receivable, payable and other liabilities.

### Estimates

The preparation of financial statements in conformity with United States Generally Accepted Accounting Principles requires management to make estimates and assumptions that affect certain reported amounts and disclosures. Accordingly, actual results could differ from those estimates.

### Fair Value Definition and Hierarchy

Fair value is defined as the price that would be received to sell an asset or paid to transfer a liability in an orderly transaction between market participants at the measurement date. The Foundation follows the provision for fair value measurements which establishes a fair value hierarchy that prioritizes and ranks the input in valuation techniques to measure fair value.

The fair value hierarchy used in measuring fair value maximizes the use of observable inputs and minimizes the use of unobservable inputs by requiring that the most observable inputs be used when available. Observable inputs are those that market participants would use in pricing the asset or liability based on market data obtained from source independent of the Foundation. Unobservable inputs reflect the Foundation's assumption about the inputs market participants would use in pricing the asset or liability developed based on the best information available in the circumstances. The fair value hierarchy consists of:

- Level 1 Quoted prices are available in active market for identical assets or liabilities as of the reporting date. The Foundation does not adjust the quoted price for these securities even in situations where the Foundation holds a large position and a sale could reasonably impact the quoted price.
- Level 2 Observable market inputs, other than quoted prices within Level 1, for identical or similar assets or liabilities that are observable either directly or indirectly.

### 1. Continued

### Fair Value Definition and Hierarchy, continued

Level 3 - Pricing inputs are unobservable and there is little, if any, market activity for the assets or liabilities. The inputs must be used to measure the fair value of an asset or liability when observable inputs are not available because there is little or no market activity for the asset or liability at the measurement date.

### Investments

Investments consist principally of publicly traded debt and equity securities. Fair value of investments in securities is based on the last reported sales price at December 31, 2010.

Investment in a partnership is carried at estimated fair value as determined by the general partner after giving consideration to various financial data currently available.

### Revenue Recognition

Revenues are reported as increases in unrestricted net assets unless use of the related assets are limited by donor-imposed restrictions. Expenses are reported as decreases in unrestricted net assets. Gains and losses on investments and other assets or liabilities are reported as increases or decreases in unrestricted net assets unless their use is restricted by explicit donor stipulation or by law.

### Reserve for uncollectible loans

Loans considered uncollectible are charged against the allowance account in the year they are deemed uncollectible.

### Property and Equipment

Property and equipment are carried at cost. Depreciation is computed using the straight-line method based on the assets estimated useful lives. When assets are retired or otherwise disposed of, the cost and related accumulated depreciation are removed from the accounts, and any resulting gain or loss is recognized in income for the period. The cost of maintenance and repairs is charged to operations as incurred; significant renewals and betterments are capitalized.

### **Bond Issuance Costs**

The bond issue was restructured in October 2008. Fees and expenses incurred directly in connection with the bond issue are deferred and amortized using the straight-line method over the term of the respective debt. Amortization expense amounted to \$28,664 for the years ended December 31, 2010 and 2009.

### 1. Continued

### Net Asset Classifications

The Foundation is required to report information regarding its financial position and activities according to three classes of net assets: Unrestricted Net Assets, Temporarily Restricted Net Assets, and Permanently Restricted Net Assets. Net assets are defined as follows:

<u>Unrestricted net assets</u> - net assets that are not subject to donor-imposed stipulations or the donor-imposed restrictions have expired.

<u>Temporarily Restricted net assets</u> - subject to donor-imposed stipulations that may be fulfilled by actions of the Foundation to meet the stipulations or become unrestricted at the date specified by the donor.

<u>Permanently Restricted net assets</u> - subject to donor-imposed stipulations that they be retained and invested permanently by the Foundation.

### Changes in Financial Statement Presentation

Certain reclassifications have been made to the 2009 information for comparative purposes in order to conform to the 2010 presentation.

### 2. Concentration of Credit Risk

Financial instruments that potentially subject the Foundation to concentrations of credit risk consist of cash accounts in a bank. At times, the balances in the account may be in excess of federally insured limits. At December 31, 2010, cash did not exceed federally insured limits. At December 31, 2009, cash exceeded federally insured limits by \$23,806.

### 7. Long-Term Liabilities

The Foundation restructured it's bond agreement (the "Restructured Agreement") with the Mercer County Improvement Authority (the "Authority") on October 2, 2008. Under the Restructured Agreement, the Authority issued a new Variable Rate Demand Obligations Series 2008 (the "Bonds") in the amount of \$21,545,000. The bonds are to be used in connection with specified purposes as described in the 1998 bond agreement. The variable rate bonds require monthly interest payments with an interest rate of 0.41% at December 31, 2010. The Foundation, may convert the bonds to a term rate or fixed rate instrument, after which, semi-annual interest payments will be required. In connection with the Restructured Agreement, the Authority also entered into a trust indenture with a bank to serve as trustee and tender agent. Interest is payable monthly to the trustee through 2028. The trust indenture is secured by a letter of credit and a liquidity facility issued by another bank in the face amount of the Bonds plus any unpaid interest. The liquidity facility contains restrictive covenants including a liquidity ratio. The Foundation pays fees for the liquidity facility and remarketing services related to the Bonds. The Revenue Refunding Bonds mature on September 1, 2028.

On October 2, 2008, Bank of America issued a commercial loan to the Foundation, which matures on November 1, 2014. At December 31, 2010, the loan balance is \$4,275,000. The commercial loan requires monthly interest payments with an interest rate of 0.61% at December 31, 2010. Interest is payable monthly to the trustee through 2014.

See footnote 1 (i) for related bond issuance cost disclosure.

### 8. Federal Excise Tax

The Atlantic Foundation is a private foundation and is exempt from Federal income taxes under 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code. An excise tax of 2% of net investment income is imposed however. The Foundation must meet certain requirements to be subject to a Federal excise tax of 1% of net investment income which is determined on the accrual basis of accounting.

The Foundation is required by the Internal Revenue Code to distribute 5% of the average fair market value of its investment assets during the year or be subject to a tax of 15% of undistributed income. The distribution must be made by the end of the subsequent year.

### 9. Subsequent Events

The Foundation is retiring a portion of the Mercer County Improvement Authority bond. In March 2011, the Foundation re-paid \$3,600,000 of the bond.

Management has evaluated and noted no subsequent events, except noted above, through May 3, 2011 the date which the financial statements were available for issue.
