### General Explanation and Request for Abatement of Penalties for Reasonable Cause

This Trust was funded in December, 2000. This is the eleventh return for the trust, the first return having been filed for the short period December 1, 2000, through December 31, 2000, and subsequent returns having been filed for the calendar years 2001 through 2009, inclusive.

The Trust was funded exclusively by a bequest under the Will of Arden Wolff, deceased. The beneficiaries of the trust are four charities:

1. Jewish Family Service of Atlantic and Cape May Counties, Ventnor, New Jersey.
2. Shore Memorial Hospital, Somers Point, New Jersey.
3. Ruth Newman Shapiro Cancer & Heart Memorial Fund, Egg Harbor Township, New Jersey.
4. Congregation Beth Israel, Northfield, New Jersey.

The sole reason for the late filing of this return was that the preparer did not prepare the return for the Trust. Neither the Trustees of the Trust nor the beneficiaries of the Trust had any culpability in the late filing. In fact, the Trustees believed that the return had been filed.

If a penalty is assessed on the late filing, it will work to the detriment of the charities that are the sole beneficiaries of this Trust.

It is requested that any penalties for late filing be abated.
