In Pennsylvania, IPIP works in conjunction with the PA Chronic Care Initiative, a program of the Governor's Office of Health Care Reform, The goal of this initiative is to assist practices in implementing the "Chronic Care Model" initially for adult diabetes and pediatric asthma patients and to become patient-centered medical homes.
