The other expenses list in 990 ez part I line 16 include program related expenses for the two annual National American Chemical Society meetings and the annual Computers in Chemistry Division planning retreat: 1) a Computers in Chemistry poster session is held at both national meetings 2) a computer projector was purchased to facilitate planning and used during the planning retreat 3) leadership training with the American Chemical Society 4) the travel, lodging and meal expense reimbursements for the Computers in Chemistry Division members serving the voting role of Councilor at the American Chemical Society meetings and 5) office supplies and operations. Additionally, during the 2010 year the American Chemical Society Investment Pool was closed out and deposited in the operating account. Subsequently, 75,000.00 was then invested with Vanguard which is listed as an investment expense.

990 ez line 20 other changes in net assets or fund values includes the \$32,383 cost basis of the ACS Investment Pool, that cost had been incurred in a year prior to 2010 and so does not show during this accounting period. The closeout amount of the ACS Investment Pool in August differed from the market value listed from the beginning of the year amount. There was a \$700 unrealized gain in the Vanguard account investment.
