

The purpose of the Franklin Electric Charitable and Educational Foundation Scholarship Program is to aid qualified students who are children of employees to obtain a college education through the Franklin Electric Charitable and Educational Foundation, Inc.

1.0 Employee Eligibility

- 1.1 Employees whose children make application for a scholarship must:
- a. As of June I each calendar year have two or more years of continuous full-time service with Franklin Electric, or with a wholly owned subsidiary, and
 - b. Be actively employed when the award is made,
- 1.2 Employees who are otherwise qualified, but are on official leave of absence for medical or military purposes are eligible.

2.0 Candidates Eligibility

- 2.1 The children of eligible Franklin Electric employees who apply for a scholarship must:
- a. Be a high school senior and graduate in the upper one-half of their graduating class
 - Submit to Franklin Electric Co., Inc. Benefits Dept. a written application requesting consideration for a scholarship.
- c. Take either the Scholastic Aptitude Test or the National Merit Scholarship Qualifying Test, and submit other necessary scholastic or financial information as required.
- d. Enter a college or university within 12 months after completing high school.
- e. The college or university must be accredited by one of the major academic accrediting services.
 - f. The student must pursue an academic program that leads to a baccalaureate degree in the normal course of study.
 - 2.2 Children of employees must be of natural relationship or legally adopted.

3.0 Award of Scholarship

- 3.1 The Franklin Electric Charitable and Educational Foundation, Inc. will appoint a special committee to review the applicants for scholarship.
- a. This committee will, upon considering the scholastic attainment of the applicants in the last three years of high school, the results of the required tests, their character, and their demonstrated citizenship, make the award.
- 3.2 Each scholarship will be awarded for four (4) consecutive years if the recipient successfully completes each year of study
