oration. Members who do not attend two consecutive annual meetings without just cause are dropped from corporate membership.
PART VI, Section A, Line 7a The Board of Directors is comprised of 14 members, 9 with three year terms, and 5 with one year terms.
Annually, three of the 3 year terms expire and these vacancies are filled at the annual meeting by vote of the corporate membership based
on a slate of candidates provided by the nominating committee or nominations from the floor. The 5 one year terms are filled by vote of
the Board of Directors based on a slate of candidates also provided by the nominating committee.
PART VI, Section B, Line 11b The Form 990 is prepared by the Treasurer of the Corporation who provides copies for perusal and questions
from the Board of Directors at a regularly scheduled meeting either prior to submission to the IRS or directly thereafter, depending on how
meeting and submission dates coincide. The form is also reviewed by the corporate audit committee during their annual audit.
PART VI, Section C, Line 19- All financial statements and governing documents are made available upon specific request and subsequent
approval of the Board of Directors. Financial results and plans are presented in detail by the Treasurer at the annual corporate meeting.
PART XII, Line 2 c Corporate By-Laws provide for an audit committee consisting of three members of the Board of Directors. Positions on
the Audit Committee are filled bi-annually on a rotating basis to assure independence and objectivity.
