The attached IRS Form 990-PF is filed for the calendar year 2010 and is the initial return for the taxpayer, the Edna Thomas Memorial Charitable Trust. The following is an explanation for the filing of the attached return at this time.

The Edna Thomas Memorial Charitable Trust was created under paragraph SECOND B of the revocable trust agreement of Edna Thomas dated March 18, 1983 in which she named Girard Bank as sole trustee. Girard Bank became, by merger, Mellon Bank, N.A., and is now BNY Mellon, N.A. Mrs. Thomas died on June 19, 2000.

Following Mrs. Thomas's death, an employee of Mellon Bank, Thomas R. Mooers, fraudulently siphoned funds from Mrs. Thomas's trust account without the knowledge of his employer and co-workers. Between June, 2000 and January, 2004, Mr. Mooers stole approximately \$650,000 from Mrs. Thomas's trust account. At the same time, Mr. Mooers prevented the probate of Mrs. Thomas's will and the timely administration of her estate. Mr. Mooers' illegal actions stalled the proper administration of the Edna Thomas Memorial Charitable Trust, including its initial funding.

An indictment was filed in April, 2008 by the United States Attorney for the Eastern District of Pennsylvania charging Mr. Mooers with bank fraud and tax evasion. In 2009, Mr. Mooers was convicted on the charges and sentenced to 37 months in federal prison.

Following a full investigation and the preparation of an accounting of Mrs. Thomas's trust, BNY Mellon, N.A. paid \$647,725 of principal and \$167,092 of income to Mrs. Thomas's trust account on December 31, 2009 to replace the funds stolen by Mr. Mooers. The Edna Thomas Memorial Charitable Trust was then funded on December 31, 2009.

The trustee, BNY Mellon, N.A., filed a Form 1023 for the Edna Thomas Memorial Charitable Trust on or about February 1, 2012. Per the subsequent determination letter dated March 27, 2012, the Edna Thomas Memorial Charitable Trust was an organization exempt from Federal income tax under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended (the "Code") as of December 31, 2009. The Edna Thomas Memorial Charitable Trust is a private foundation within the meaning of section 509(a) of the Code. A copy of the determination letter is attached hereto.

As a result, the trustee, BNY Mellon, N.A., is now filing a Form 990-PF for each of the calendar years, 2010 and 2011. A 2012 Form 990-PF for the Edna Thomas Memorial Charitable Trust was timely filed.
