Guidelines

How to Apply

- MCM Foundation will consider grants to assist credible agencies and institutions serving children and youth, and projects benefiting general education endeavors. Grant requests from credible agencies or institutions will be entertained both for specific programs and for capital expenditures.
- Consideration will be given to the support of well conceived experimental or demonstration projects in program areas of grant focus that promise significant positive results and are likely to produce long-term multiplier effects.
- Grants are usually awarded for a limited period of time. Some grants may be paid over a multi-year period; however, the Foundation generally does not approve grants to any organization on a continuing annual basis. Final action on all grants will be determined by the Foundation Board of Directors.
- Grants are awarded to children and institutions located in the Bay Area including San Francisco, Marin, Alameda, Contra Costa, Sonoma, Solano, San Mateo, Napa and Santa Clara counties.

Send Request Letter

If, after reviewing the guidelines, there is sufficient reason to believe that the Foundation's funding priorities and interests are compatible with the needs of the organization seeking support, then a brief test letter should be addressed to the President of mcm Foundation.

All test letters will be given an in-depth screening to determine their relevance to the Foundation's funding priorities and interests. In most instances, written responses will be sent promptly to the applicant.

On the letterhead of the applicant organization or institution, the following information must be included in the Test letter:

1. Any of the following not included on the letterhead. organization's legal name, mailing address, city, state, zip, phone and fax numbers, e-mail and web site address, if available.
2. A brief description of the organization.
3. A brief description of the project for which funding is sought.
4. The total cost of the project for which funding is sought.
5. The amount requested from the mcm Foundation. The Foundation expects all applicant organizations to show substantial support from internal sources as well as other outside sources.
6. First time applicants must include a copy of the IRS 501(c)(3) ruling for the organization or institution.
7. Optional one copy of any supporting data that the applicant selects may accompany the test letter.

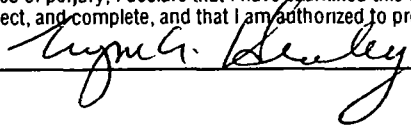
