### 1. Save the Future Education Scheme for poor children

Dropout rates from schools due to financial needs continue to stay higher in comparison to other districts, especially in government run schools. GCF identified these areas with higher numbers of financially restrained families in Jammu and Kashmir State, India. "Save the future" program serves as an essential component of the educational program of GCF. This program focuses on high school completion, career development, and future preparation for youth who are at a critical juncture in their life and especially at risk of dropping out.

### Philosophy and Vision

The goal of this project is to reduce the dropout rate to minimal and eliminate the socioeconomic reason for a child to not complete their education especially when they are at this critical juncture from ninth to twelfth grade of schooling.GCF provides no money in hand but does provide tuition in school, textbooks and reference books with examination fees if eligible. This has served over 450 children in over 7 schools.

Strengthening and supporting education is the primary focus of "save the future" program under Guru Scholars Program. Our hope for every child is that they grow to be educated and lead into the future. We strive to help educate all children despite financial difficulties irrespective of religion, caste and creed. We believe that a human being can only realize his or her own value and potential after being educated enough to meet the challenges of life.

### 2. Vision for All (Vision screening for Schools)

### Rationale

According to World Health Organization screening done with rapid and simple tests should be considered as initial step of such care. Schools have a long-established tradition of engaging in vision screening. Furthermore, school vision screening has proven to be effective in detecting previously undiagnosed conditions

### Pathway

The scheme was initiated in schools in 2009. All children are assessed in a systemic fashion. In summary a child's comprehensive eye examination include testing of the following visual skills,

### **Project Evaluation**

During this period (start-up phase of the program), GCF has screened 51 primary schools with over 3500 children and given glasses to over 150 children.

Local working group provides feedback at three month intervals to the program for further review and guidance. The data is reviewed and evaluated at a yearly interval.

### 3. Women's Health Initiative

### MISSION STATEMENT

The goals of this program are two-fold: We attempted not only to improve public understanding of general medical illnesses in the region of Kashmir valley but also to initiate the first dedicated cancer prevention program. Our objective is to establish a largely self-sufficient women health program especially for breast cancer in Jammu and Kashmir State, India.

The GT public awareness programs mission has

- 1. Educated the public through free brochures & TV advertisements
- 2. Set up an epidemiological database
- 3. Attempt to identify high risk patients for further close monitoring
- 4. Future follow-up at regular intervals to evaluate response

### PROGRAM DESCRIPTION

### Methodology & Activities

WHI has initiated a complete epidemiological database (developed by our advisory committee), develop local language self breast examination brochure and trained local field workers to start the program. In the second phase, we launched the house to house teaching, completion of self examination with population of database. Education for field workers and public education has been initiated and over 5 villages with over a 1000 women have been educated and enrolled in the program. All women across the globe are at risk for breast cancer especially women at high risk. GCF wishes to raise public awareness of breast cancer in Jammu and Kashmir State and to establish a breast cancer program. This program will provide a unique opportunity for the local community to reform this sub-standard sector of health care.
