



The David R. McShane Charitable Foundation was established on February 29, 2008 by David R. McShane, a current resident of New Hope, Pennsylvania, to create a perpetual entity for the receipt, investment, management and control of funds and contributions to be collected and received from the friends and family of David R. McShane, as well as the general public, for the purpose of encouraging support for charitable, scientific, literary and educational purposes within the meaning of those terms as used in Section 501(c) 3 of the Internal Revenue Code by making grants and contributing to charitable organizations that David R. McShane has supported [and wishes to support in the future] in the Commonwealths of Pennsylvania and Virginia and the States of New Jersey and Connecticut.

David R. McShane [the "Donor"] formed the Foundation as a charitable corporation - a not for profit entity - [a nonprofit domestic corporation in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania] on February 29, 2008.

It is the intent of the Donor to augment the Foundation's assets through a devise of a portion of his testamentary estate. The Foundation was recognized as a Section 501(c)3 tax exempt private foundation by the Internal Revenue Service by Ruling dated November 20, 2008.

The Foundation is perpetual, and unless terminated, in which case the Foundation is to distribute the Foundation's assets to such one or more charitable organizations selected by the Foundation, each of which is organized and operated exclusively for charitable purposes and which at the time of distribution shall qualify for exemption under Section 501(c)3 of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as from time to time amended.

The Foundation will seek contributions primarily from individuals and invest the funds received and to make grants consistent with the Donor stated intent. The Foundation will meet periodically to further the goals of the Foundation and to select such one or more charitable organizations to receive distributions and/or grants from the Foundation. To date, given the limited resources of the Foundation, the Foundation has not made any grants.




