Amended and Restated Articles of Incorporation

Friends of the John Smith Chesapeake Trail, Inc., a Maryland non-stock corporation, hereby certifies to the State Department of Assessments and Taxation in Maryland that:

The Articles of Incorporation of Friends of the John Smith Chesapeake Trail, Inc. are hereby Amended and Restated to read in its entirety as follows:

I, Thomas B. Lewis, whose address is 218 North Charles Street, Suite 400, Baltimore, Maryland 21201, being at least eighteen (18) years of age, am hereby forming a non-stock corporation under and by virtue of the General Laws of the State of Maryland.

ARTICLE ONE

NAME OF CORPORATION

The name of the corporation (which is hereafter called the "Conservancy") is "Chesapeake Conservancy, Inc."

ARTICLE TWO

PURPOSES

The Conservancy is organized and shall be operated exclusively for religious, charitable, and educational purposes within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue law) (hereinafter referred to as the "Code"). The specific purposes for which the Conservancy is formed are:

- o To facilitate the implementation of the Captain John Smith Chesapeake National Historic Trail (the "Trail") and the Chesapeake Bay Gateways and Watertrails Network (the "Gateways Network"), promote its use, and advocate on its behalf, in cooperation and conjunction with the National Park Service;
- o To promote appreciation, cooperative conservation and citizen stewardship of the Trail and of the Chesapeake Bay and its tributaries;
- o To help educate the public about John Smith's momentous journeys, native American cultures in the Chesapeake watershed, and the changes that have occurred in the watershed over the past 400 years;
- o To promote sustainable tourism and recreation, conservation of significant landscapes, and improved public access associated with the Trail;
- o To work with local, state, and federal agencies, businesses, non-profit organizations and other persons to further enhance public access, stewardship,

educational and conservation activities in the Chesapeake Bay and its tributaries; and

o To raise funds and promote the contribution of resources to help implement the Trail and the Gateways Network.

In furtherance of these purposes, the Conservancy may:

- o Receive contributions and property, tangible and intangible, from any person, firm or corporation and own, hold, manage, invest, and reinvest the same, and to apply the income and principal thereof in such manner and at such times as the Conservancy may deem best to carry out the charitable purposes described herein;
- o Acquire, own, hold, develop, manage, lease and invest and reinvest in real or personal property, tangible or intangible, and to borrow monies with respect to the acquisition of and investment in such property;
- Otherwise operate exclusively for charitable, community benefit, scientific and educational purposes within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the Code; and
- O Have and exercise to the extent necessary or desirable for the accomplishment of any of the aforesaid purposes, and to the extent that they are not inconsistent with the charitable purposes of the Conservancy, any and all powers exercisable by non-stock corporations under the Maryland General Corporation Law, together with the power to solicit grants and contributions for such purposes.

ARTICLE THREE

PRINCIPAL OFFICE

The address of the principal office of the Conservancy in this State is: 410 Severn Avenue, Suite 405, Annapolis, MD 21403

ARTICLE FOUR

RESIDENT AGENT.

The name and address of the Resident Agent in this State is: Charles A. Stek, 18611 Mink Hollow Road, Highland, Maryland 20777. Said Resident Agent is an individual actually residing in this State.

ARTICLE FIVE

NONSTOCK CORPORATION

The Conservancy is a non-stock corporation, and no dividends or pecuniary profits will be declared or inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to, any member, Director or officer of the Conservancy, or any other private person. The Conservancy has no authority to issue capital stock. All the earnings and property of the corporation shall be used to further the purposes and objectives of the corporation as set forth in Article Two.

Nothing contained herein, however, shall prohibit payments by the Conservancy to directors or officers or members as reasonable compensation for services rendered to the corporation.

ARTICLE SIX

DURATION

The period of duration of this nonprofit corporation is perpetual until such time as the Conservancy is dissolved according to the laws of the State of Maryland and of the bylaws of the corporation.

ARTICLE SEVEN

DIRECTORS

The number of directors constituting the board of directors shall not be more than 20, which number may be increased or decreased pursuant to the Bylaws of the Conservancy provided that the number of directors shall never be less than the minimum number permitted by Section 2-402 of the Corporations and Associations Article of the Annotated Code of Maryland, as amended. ARTICLE EIGHT

LIABILITY

The private property of the members, directors and officers of the Conservancy shall not be liable for its corporate debts.

Directors and Officers and Members of the Conservancy shall not be liable to the Conservancy for money damages. The purpose of this limitation of liability is to limit liability to the maximum extent that the liability of directors and officers of Maryland corporations is permitted to be limited by Maryland law, as amended. This limitation on

liability shall apply to events occurring at the time a person serves as a director or officer of the Conservancy whether or not such person serves as a director or officer at the time of any proceeding in which liability is asserted.

To the maximum extent permitted by Maryland law, the Conservancy shall indemnify its currently acting and its former directors and officers against any and all liabilities and expenses incurred in connection with their services in such capacities, and shall indemnify its currently acting and its former officers to the full extent that indemnification shall be provided to directors, and shall indemnify, to the same extent, persons who serve and have served, at its request as a director, officer, partner, trustee, employee or agent of another corporation, partnership, joint venture or other enterprise. The Conservancy shall advance expenses to its directors and officers and the other persons referred to above to the extent permitted by Maryland law. This indemnification of directors and officers shall also apply to directors and officers who are also employees, in their capacity as employees. The Board of Directors may by Bylaw, resolution or agreement make further provision for indemnification of employees and agents to the extent permitted by Maryland law.

References to Maryland law shall include the Maryland General Corporation Law as from time to time amended. Neither the repeal or amendment of this Article Eight, nor any other amendment to these Articles of Incorporation, shall eliminate or reduce the protection afforded to any person by the foregoing provisions of this Article Eight with respect to any act or omission which shall have occurred prior to such repeal or amendment.

ARTICLE NINE

PROHIBITED ACTIVITIES

Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, the Conservancy shall not, except to an insubstantial degree, engage in any activities or exercise any powers that are not in furtherance of the purposes of the Conservancy.

Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, the Conservancy shall not conduct or carry on any activities not permitted to be conducted or carried on (a) by a corporation exempt from Federal income tax under Section 501(c)(3) of the Code or (ii) by a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under Sections 170(c)(2), 2055(a)(2) and 2522(a)(2) of the Code. No substantial part of the activities of the Conservancy shall consist of lobbying or propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, except as permitted by Section 501(h) of the Code, and the Conservancy shall not participate in or intervene in any political campaign on behalf of or in opposition to any candidate for public office.

During any fiscal year of the Conservancy that it is determined to be a private foundation as defined in Section 509(a) of the Code, the Conservancy:

- Shall distribute its income for such taxable year at such time and in such manner as not to become subject to the tax on undistributed income imposed by Section 4942 of the Code:
- o Shall not engage in any act of self-dealing as defined in Section 4941(d) of the Code:
- o Shall not retain any excess business holdings as defined in Section 4943(c) of the Code:
- o Shall not make any investments in such manner as to subject it to tax under Section 4944 of the Code; and

ARTICLE TEN

MEMBERS

The Board of Directors shall have the power to provide in the Bylaws of the corporation that the corporation shall or shall not have a membership. If a membership is so provided for, the qualifications of members, their manner of selection, any classes of membership, and the rights, duties and voting privileges of members shall be established in the Bylaws of the corporation.

ARTICLE ELEVEN

DISSOLUTION OF THE CORPORATION

No person shall possess any property right in or to the property or assets of the Conservancy. Upon dissolution of the Conservancy as provided by the Bylaws, all assets remaining after payment of any outstanding liabilities shall be distributed exclusively to charitable, religious, educational or scientific organizations which would then qualify under the provisions of Section 501(c)(3) of the Code and which organizations have purposes and objectives similar to those of the Conservancy all determined in accordance with the Bylaws.

ARTICLE TWELVE

AMENDMENTS

In accordance with its Bylaws, the Conservancy reserves the right to make from time to time, by the vote of a majority of the entire Board of Directors, any amendment to these Articles which may now or hereafter be authorized by law, provided that no amendment shall be made which shall cause the Corporation to lose its exemption from Federal income tax under Section 501(c)(3) of the Code.

ARTICLE THIRTEEN

EFFECT

The foregoing Amended and Restated Articles of Incorporation shall supersede the existing Articles of Incorporation, dated January 31, 2008.

THE FOREGOING has been duly advised and approved by the Board of Directors of the Conservancy in the manner required by the Bylaws of the Corporation and the laws of the State of Maryland.
