Community Investment LWC's community investment strategy funds community coalitions working on healthy eating and active living strategies at the local level In 2010, LiveWell Colorado awarded \$3.78 million in funding to 23 communities across the state. In addition to financial support, LiveWell Colorado provides technical assistance and opportunities for shared knowledge and collaborations. Since its inception in 2007, the community grants program has benefited more than half a million Coloradoans. Supporting our Communities. Unlike typical fundor relationships, LWC cultivates rich partnerships with the communities if funds. In addition to financial support provided through a seven-year funding cycle, LiveWell Colorado strives to build capacity in each of the funded communities by offering technical assistance, conducting site visits and providing community networking and training opportunities. In 2010, training agendas included webinars, roundtable discussions on school policy, food systems, early childhood, active community environments and coalition building, as well as networking opportunities and grassroots advocacy training.

Communication To further establish a leadership position, LWC's communication strategy focused on elevating the issue of obesity among opinion-leaders, stakeholders and the general public, as well as conveying LWC's approach to tackling the complex obesity epidemic. Media outreach told the story and built credibility. LWC was highlighted in more than 60 newspapers, nearly half were outside the Denver metro area. LWC was featured in 11 stories on nine television stations. Strategic communication tools engaged stakeholders and facilitated discussions. LWC re-launched its website to be more content-rich, interactive and useful to stakeholders. LWC continued its communication strategy from 2009 into 2010. In 2010 LWC was featured in 330 stories in a variety of media, including major stories in the Denver Post, 5280 Magazine, on NPR, on every major Colorado network TV station, national websites and a variety of other media outlets. Monthly Website visits increased 45% from 2009, the E-Newsletter has 1,000 recipients monthly. LWC also held five Webinars attended by over 300 people from across the country.

POLICY AND EDUCATION LWC is leading the development of a series of Policy Blueprints which assess current initiatives, recommend actionable strategies, and provide overall direction for statewide efforts regarding specific policy topics 🔺 WORKSITE WELLNESS. As part of its vision to promote an environment where every Coloradoan has access to healthy foods and opportunities for physical activity in the places they live, work, learn and play, LWC has developed a Worksite Wellness Blueprint to identify the current state of worksite wellness in Colorado and to identify, prioritize, and quide future efforts. LWC collaborated with the Healthy Living Branch of the Colorado Department of Public Health and Environment, which is building a framework to guide employers' actions. The Blueprint is informed by stakeholder input collected through meetings, surveys, and interviews * FOOD POLICY LWC's approach to promting healthy eating includes ensuring access to healthy foods for all Coloradoans, advancing nutritional competency, and supporting behavior changes. The focus of the Food Policy Blueprint is specifically on access and policy efforts in the food policy domain. In 2010, The Colorado Food Systems Advisory Council was established by a LiveWell Colorado-initiated bill to create robust and resilient food systems within Colorado Developing a sustainable food system that provides Coloradoans with greater access to fresh and healthy food is a key element in slowing the obesity trend and making Colorado a healthier state while improving our economy * BUILT ENVIRONMENT LWC's Built Environment Policy Blueprint begins to examine how the built environment (buildings, spaces and products that are created or modified by people including homes, schools, businesses, workplaces, parks, transportation systems, waste disposal and electric transmission) may be impacting health outcomes throughout Colorado Initial analysis and recommendations are made within the duel contexts of geography (rural, urban, suburban and resort) and discipline (land use, development and active transportation) * HEAL COALITION The HEAL Coalition includes a broad range of organizations interested in improving health outcomes in Colorado including the reduction of obesity through state, federal and local policy change. In addition to LWC as the lead facilitator and convener, the HEAL Coalition Steering Committee also includes The Colorado Health Foundation and the Colorado Children's Campaign. The Coalition has identified four priority areas around which their efforts are focused 1) physical activity and education for preschool through grade 12, 2) school food for preschool through grade 12, 3) active transportation, and 4) food access and security
