DE LASKI, PRESIDENT AND FOUNDER OF THE VIBRANT VILLAGE FOUNDATION.

THE VIBRANT VILLAGE FOUNDATION IS CONTROLLED BY KENNETH E. DE LASKI, THE SON OF THE FOUNDER OF THE DE LASKI FAMILY FOUNDATION. KATHLEEN DE LASKI GRUBB, THE DAUGHTER OF THE FOUNDER OF THE DE LASKI FAMILY FOUNDATION, IS A DIRECTOR OF THE DE LASKI FAMILY FOUNDATION AND THE VIBRANT VILLAGE FOUNDATION. THE VIBRANT VILLAGE FOUNDATION AND THE DE LASKI FAMILY FOUNDATION ARE EFFECTIVELY CONTROLLED BY THE SAME PERSONS WITHIN THE MEANING OF REGULATION SEC. 1.482-1(a)(3).

THE SUBSTANTIAL CONTRIBUTORS OF THE DE LASKI FAMILY FOUNDATION ARE SUBSTANTIAL CONTRIBUTORS OF THE VIBRANT VILLAGE FOUNDATION. SEC. 507(d)(2). AS DISCLOSED ON STATEMENT 13, DONALD DE LASKI BECAME A SUBSTANTIAL CONTRIBUTOR TO THE VIBRANT VILLAGE FOUNDATION AS A RESULT OF THIS TRANSFER. KENNETH E. DE LASKI BECAME A SUBSTANTIAL CONTRIBUTOR TO THE VIBRANT VILLAGE FOUNDATION IN 2009. DE LASKI FAMILY FOUNDATION BECAME A SUBSTANTIAL CONTRIBUTOR TO THE VIBRANT VILLAGE FOUNDATION AS DEFINED IN SEC. 507(d)(2). FOR PURPOSES OF SEC. 4941 (RELATED TO TAXES ON SELF-DEALING), THE TERM SUBSTANTIAL CONTRIBUTOR DOES NOT INCLUDE ANY ORGANIZATION WHICH IS DEFINED IN SEC. 501(c)(3). (REGULATION SEC. 1.507-6(a)(2).) THE DE LASKI FAMILY FOUNDATION IS AN ORGANIZATION DESCRIBED IN SEC. 501(c)(3) AND THEREFORE IT IS NOT A SUBSTANTIAL CONTRIBUTOR TO THE VIBRANT VILLAGE FOUNDATION FOR PURPOSE OF SEC. 4941.

PURSUANT TO REGULATION SEC. 1.507-3 AND REVENUE RULING 78-387, THE VIBRANT VILLAGE FOUNDATION IS TREATED AS IF IT IS THE DE LASKI FAMILY FOUNDATION WITH RESPECT TO CERTAIN TAX ATTRIBUTES.

THE AVERAGE VALUE OF THE ASSETS AND THE EXCESS DISTRIBUTION CARRYOVERS OF THE DE LASKI FAMILY FOUNDATION HAVE BEEN ALLOCATED TO THE VIBRANT VILLAGE FOUNDATION BASED ON A RATIO OF THE FAIR MARKET VALUE OF THE ASSETS TRANSFERRED BY THE DE LASKI FAMILY FOUNDATION TO THE VIBRANT VILLAGE FOUNDATION TO THE TOTAL FAIR MARKET VALUE OF THE ASSETS OF THE DE LASKI FAMILY FOUNDATION IMMEDIATELY PRIOR TO THE TRANSFER. THIS ALLOCATION IS DETAILED IN STATEMENT 16.
