Mission is to channel resources to alleviate the suffering of the people of Aceh while empowering local people to achieve sustainable community development. Aceh is the worst affected location in this natural disaster, with massive loss of life and destruction of infrastructure. The people of Aceh have also suffered during armed conflict that has lasted for more than 30 years.  Methodology includes establishing pilot projects of plantation and nurseries for cash crops and animal husbandry which are being used as showroom and training center for agricultural projects in neighboring villages. Serving 450 families(2,000) people.
