

The undersigned, acting as incorporator of a nonstock corporation under the Wisconsin Nonstock Corporation Law, Chapter 181 of the Wisconsin Statutes (the "WNCL"), hereby adopts the following Articles of Incorporation for such corporation:

ARTICLE I

Name

The name of the corporation is Women's Fund of Greater La Crosse, Inc.



ARTICLE II

Purposes

ARTICLE III

Activities and Restrictions

Section 1. No dividends, liquidating dividends, or distributions shall be declared or paid by the corporation to any private individual or officer or director of the Corporation.

Section 2. No substantial part of the activities of the Corporation shall consist in carrying on propaganda or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, unless by appropriate election a greater part is permitted without jeopardizing the Corporation's exemption under I.R.C.

Section 501(c)(3). The Corporation shall neither participate in, nor intervene in, any political campaign on behalf of (or in opposition to) any candidate for public office, including the publishing or distribution of any statements.

Section 3. No part of the net earnings or net income of the Corporation shall inure to the benefit of any private individual or officer or director of the Corporation; provided, however, that such a person may receive reasonable compensation for personal services rendered, or reimbursement for reasonable expenses incurred, which are necessary to carrying out the exempt purposes of the Corporation.

Section 4. Notwithstanding any other provision of these Articles of Incorporation, the Corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on by a Corporation exempt from federal income tax under I.R.C. Section 501(c)(3) or by a corporation contributions to which are deductible under I.R.C. Section 170(c)(2).

Section 5. Whenever the Corporation is a private foundation as defined in I.R.C. Section 509(a), the income of the Corporation shall be distributed at such time and in such manner as not to subject it to tax under I.R.C. Section 4942 and the Corporation shall not engage in any act of self-dealing, or retain any excess business holdings, or make any taxable expenditures as define din I.R.C. Sections 4941(d), 4943(c) and 4945(d), respectively, or make any investments in such manner as to subject it to tax under I.R.C. Section 4944, or make any indemnification which would give rise to a penalty excise tax under I.R.C. Chapter 42.

ARTICLE IV

Members

The corporation shall have one or more classes of members whose respective qualifications, rights, and method of acceptance shall be as specified in the Bylaws

ARTICLE V

Directors

The affairs of the corporation shall be managed by its Board of Directors, which shall consist of such number of persons as shall be fixed by the Bylaws from time to time, but shall not be less than the number of directors required by the WNCL, which at the time of execution of these Articles is three (3). The terms of office, qualifications and method of election of the directors shall be as specified in the Bylaws.

ARTICLE VI

Director Consent Actions

Any action required or permitted to be taken at a board meeting may be taken by written action signed by two-thirds (2/3) of the directors then in office. Such action shall have the same force and effect as a vote of the board of directors taken at a meeting. All directors shall receive written notice of any action so taken, and the written action is effective on the date specified in the written consent or on the tenth day after the date on which written notice is given, whichever is later.

ARTICLE VII

Derivative Proceedings

The provisions of Sections 181.0741 to 181.0746 of the Wisconsin Statutes shall not apply to this Corporation.

ARTICLE VIII

Amendment

These Articles of Incorporation may be amended by the members of the Corporation by such vote as may at the time be required by the WNCL, provided that no amendment shall substantially change the original purposes of the corporation.

ARTICLE IX

Dissolution

In the event of the dissolution of the corporation, the Board of Directors shall, after paying or making provision for the payment of all of the liabilities of the corporation, distribute all of the assets of the corporation exclusively for purposes substantially similar to those of the corporation to one or more organizations then described in I.R.C. Sections 170(c)(2), 501(c)(3), 2055(a)(2) and 2522(a)(2) having purposes substantially similar to those of the corporation (except that no private foundation as defined by I.R.C. Section 509(a) shall be a recipient) or to one or more units or agencies of federal, state or local government to be used exclusively for public purposes, as the Board of Directors shall determine. Any of such assets not so distributed shall be distributed to one or more of such organizations as determined by the Circuit Court of the county in which the principal office of the corporation is then located.

ARTICLE X

Principal Office; Registered Office and Registered Agent

The mailing address of the principal office of the corporation is 300 Second Street North, Suite 320, La Crosse, Wisconsin 54601. The street address of the initial registered office of the corporation is 201 Main Street, Suite 700, La Crosse, Wisconsin 54601, and the initial registered agent at such address is Kara M. Burgos.

ARTICLE XI

BYLAWS

ARTICLE I THE ENTITY

1. Name

WOMEN'S FUND OF GREATER LA CROSSE, INC.

2. Office

300 Second Street North, Suite 320, La Crosse, WI 54601

3. Purpose

To promote health, safety and self-sufficiency for women and girls, enrichment opportunities for women and girls; and to encourage women and girls to develop as philanthropists.

4. Structure

The Women's Fund is a corporation operated exclusively for charitable and educational purposes within the meaning of I.R.C. Section 501(c)(3). Its Board of Directors raises money, allocates grants, and conducts public relations for the Corporation, its activities and accomplishments.

The La Crosse Community Foundation directs the investments of the Corporation as a designated fund.

5. Area of Operation

Greater La Crosse Community, including La Crosse County and surrounding areas or other areas designated in gifts or bequests accepted by the Women's Fund Board of Directors.

ARTICLE II BOARD OF DIRECTORS

1. Number

No less than seven (7) with a maximum of fifteen (15).

2. Responsibilities

Solicit grant applications and make allocations to applicants. Approve new Board directors and officers.

3. Methods of Election

Elected annually by the Board of Directors at the last regular meeting of the year or as vacancies occur.

4. Term

Directors shall hold office for a term of three (3) years, beginning on January 1 of each year. Directors may serve up to two (2) successive full terms. Any directors elected to fill a vacancy, may serve the balance of the predecessor's term and may then be elected in the same manner. The member is eligible for two (2) successive three (3) year terms, following the expiration of the predecessor's term. Board terms shall be staggered to provide continuity.

5. Vacancies

A Director may resign at any time by delivery of written notice of resignation to the Board President or the Secretary/Treasurer. Failure to attend three (3) consecutive meetings may disqualify a Director from board service.

- 6. Meetings
 - a. Board shall meet quarterly or at the direction of the President.
 - b. Special and/or regular meetings require prior notification to Directors.
 - c. A quorum shall be two-thirds of the total number of Directors.
 - d. All action of the Board shall be taken upon the affirmative vote of the majority present at a duly constituted meeting.
 - e. Robert's Rules of Order, newly revised, will be followed at Board meetings.

ARTICLE III OFFICERS

1. Number and Title

The Board shall elect annually, at the last meeting of the year, from its members, President, Vice President, and Secretary/Treasurer and such other officers as appropriate. Officers shall take office upon acceptance of position.

2. Duties

- a. President:
 - *Conducts meetings;
 - *Ex-officio member of all Women's Fund committees;
 - *Ensures Board actions are implemented;
 - *Liaison to La Crosse Community Foundation Board of Directors.
- b. Vice President:
 - *Fulfills duties of President in absence of President;
 - *Serves as President-elect;

- c. Secretary/Treasurer:
 - *Compiles minutes of board meetings;
 - *Responsible for financial statements of Women's Fund.

3. Terms of Officers:

- a. The term of President shall be one (1) year renewable with a maximum of two (2) years.
- b. The term of Vice President shall be one (1) year, renewable.
- c. The term of Secretary-Treasurer shall be one (1) year, renewable.

4. Removal of Officers:

a. Officers can be removed by 2/3 vote of Board of Directors.

ARTICLE IV COMMITTEES

1. General:

- a. Each Director shall be affiliated with one (1) or more committee(s).
- b. Chairperson of each committee shall be appointed by Women's Fund Board of Director president with approval of full Board.
- c. Committee goals/plans shall be approved by Board annually at the first regular meeting of the year.
- d. Committee members, other than chair, need not be board members.

2. Committees:

- a. Executive:
 - *Draft and implement by-laws;
 - *Prepare and pursue nominations for Board and Committees;
 - *Review committee responsibilities:
 - *Conduct business of Women's Fund;
 - *All officers will serve on Executive Committee:
 - *Committee chairs will be invited to serve on Executive Committee;
 - *The immediate past president may serve on Executive Committee at offer of President;
 - *Proposes nominations to Board and officers to Board.
- b. Finance Committee includes the Treasurer and two members of the Board of Directors:
 - *Review Financial Reports on a quarterly basis which include Profit and Loss Statements, Balance Sheets, Transaction Reports and investment adviser reports;
 - *Determines whether funds should be transferred to investments or endowments;
 - *Determines when to establish an endowment
 - *Make recommendations regarding investments and investment advisors;
 - *Annually review Internal Financial Policy, Gift Acceptance Policy and Investment Policy;
- c. Development:
 - *Develop and execute plan to increase endowment assets;
 - *Encourage women in the community to be philanthropists;

- *Recommend to Executive Committee potential Directors.
- d. Marketing and Public Relations:
 - *Promote programming of Women's Fund;
 - *Conduct marketing and public relations of Women's Fund;
 - *Recommend to Executive Committee potential Directors.
- e. Community Impact:
 - *Work with community agencies and members to explore and assess the needs of women and girls;
 - *Recommend to Executive Committee potential Directors.
- f. Events:
 - *Organize details of events to promote Women's Fund;
 - *Recommend to Executive Committee potential Directors.
- g. Other ad hoc committees as determined by the Board.

ARTICLE V

Members of the community, as selected by each Committee, will comprise the body of the Corporation. Members may serve on more than one committee.

ARTICLE VI FINANCE

- 1. Fiscal Year
 - a. Shall be January 1 through December 31.
 - b. All funds raised shall be deposited with and managed by the La Crosse Community Foundation until such time as a new fund is established by the Board.

ARTICLE VII AMENDMENTS

These bylaws may be amended by majority vote at a duly constituted meeting of the Board of Directors.
