Part IX-A summary of direct charitable activities:

1. Organization and commencement of activities. The Foundation was organized on August 26, 2010 and was incorporated as a Virginia non-stock not-for-profit corporation on August 30, 2010. The Foundation is a 501(c)(3) tax exempt grant-making private foundation devoted to charitable, scientific, literary and educational purposes, particularly the care of and prevention of cruelty to animals, the support of the arts, and the support of childhood education through the encouragement, recognition and reward, by means of scholarships, fellowships, prizes and/or awards, of outstanding or exceptional academic achievement, primarily by elementary, middle and secondary school students, particularly in the areas of physics, chemistry, mathematics, the performing and fine arts, reading,

language and literature. By-laws and a conflicts of interest policy were adopted by the board of directors on September 15, 2010, officers were appointed, banking resolutions were passed, and the Foundation commenced operations. The Foundation applied for tax exempt status under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code on October 7, 2010 and received a favorable response on February 14, 2011, retroactive to August 30, 2010. An expense reimbursement policy was adopted on November 15, 2010.

2. Commencement of grant-making activities. During the period between September 1 and December 31, 2010, the Foundation began discussions with representatives of six potential grant beneficiaries. No grants were made nor authorized during fiscal 2010, but on February 1, 2011, the board of directors declared that, based upon the financial position of the Foundation as of December 31, 2010, fiscal 2010 grants totaling \$1,000 would be authorized for award and payment during 2011. Thereafter, a grant in the amount of \$100 was approved on February 1, 2011, and a grant for \$900 was approved on March 7, 2011.

Part X line 4 cash held for charitable activities:

Since the Foundation just began operations at the end of 2010, its assets consist primarily of a small amount of cash resulting from contributions. As discussed above (Part IX-A item 2) grants for fiscal 2010 totaling \$1000 were disbursed in early 2011. The Treasurer is of the opinion that at least another \$1000 of the Foundation's cash balance will be needed during 2011 for administrative and operating expenses. Therefore, the sum of \$2000 has been deemed "held for charitable activities" in Part X line 4 even though this amount exceeds the 1-1/2% general rule.

Part X line 6 short tax period:

Since the Foundation began operations on September 1, 2010, the minimum investment return multiplier of $5\% \times 0.334 = 0.0167$ has been used.
