Principle of Ethical Conduct and Whistleblower Policy

A. General

The Society of Family Planning (the "Corporation") is committed to facilitating open and honest communications relevant to its governance, finances, and compliance with all applicable laws and regulations. The Corporation's goal is for each director, officer, employee and volunteer (individually, "Representative" and collectively, "Representatives"), whether full-time or part-time, to conduct him or herself in an honest and principled fashion, and to act in good faith with others, both within and outside of the Corporation (the "Principle of Ethical Conduct"). The Corporation expects that Representatives will comply with the letter and spirit of the Principle of Ethical Conduct.

B. Responsibility

All Representatives must adhere to the Principle of Ethical Conduct and submit a good faith report of suspected violations of the Principle of Ethical Conduct or of a suspected Financial Impropriety, in accordance with Section C.

"Financial Impropriety" means a deliberate act or failure to act with the intention of obtaining an unauthorized benefit for any private person or entity, or any action or inaction, whether or not intentional, which is or may be a violation of any statute, regulation or Corporation policy involving the use of Corporation funds or assets.

"Good faith" means that the Representative making the report has reasonable grounds for believing the report is true and accurate and the conduct may be a violation of the Principle of Ethical Conduct or a Financial Impropriety.

Any report not made in good faith will subject the Representative to serious disciplinary action, including possible termination of employment or termination of status as an officer or member of the board.

C. Reporting Procedures

1. If the suspected violation involves the President or if the Representative is uncomfortable reporting the matter to the President, the Representative shall report the matter to the Treasurer.

2. If the Representative is not comfortable reporting the matter to the Treasurer, the Representative shall report the matter to any other member of the Board of Directors.

The report may be made anonymously.

D. Handling of Reported Violations

A Representative who is the recipient of, or handling, a suspected violation of the Principle of Ethical Conduct or commission of a Financial Impropriety shall preserve the confidentiality of the Representative making the report to the greatest extent possible without impeding a full and fair investigation.

E. No Retaliation

If a Representative reports a violation of the Principle of Ethical Conduct or Financial Impropriety in good faith, he or she shall not suffer harassment, retaliation or adverse employment action, as a result. Any Representative who harasses, retaliates or takes any adverse action against the employment status or officer or board status of the individual who reported the violation of the Principle of Ethical Conduct shall be subject to discipline, including possible termination of employment or termination of status as an officer or member of the board.
