


Our Care Consultants will conduct free in-home assessments and can arrange a variety of services through-out our network of partners such as home delivered meals, personal care, adult day care, caregiver support and respite services, nursing services, emergency response systems, homemaker services, minor home repair, medical transportation, behavioral health counseling, prescription access, medical bill and insurance counseling, legal aid clinics and numerous other services and programs are available. In addition, we have an Activity Center designed to focus on prevention, wellness, education, socialization and recreation, which includes an exercise pool, computer training lab, library, dance, aerobics, arts and many other activities designed specifically for older adults.

Hospitality and Event Services: Hospitality services provide additional nutrition options for Seniors at the Center for Older Adults.
