1. Foundation's Charitable Activities by Ms. Jacquelin Cochran (Foundation Project Manager). The Allen Foundation (the "Foundation") was formed on April 25, 2000, for the purpose of providing humanitarian and development aid to individuals in the most desperate areas of the world. To accomplish its charitable purposes, the Foundation began work in Cambodia, a country that has suffered almost unimaginable devastation and poverty for over three decades.

The Foundation's Project Manager, Jacquelin Cochran, holds a degree from Pomona College in Public Policy and Physics and received graduate training through the Energy & Resources Department at the University of California at Berkeley where she specialized in the use of water purification and renewable energy technologies in South-East Asia. She also has relevant work experience through her role as a Peace Corps volunteer from 1997 through 1999.

2. **Joint Venture with Stung Treng Women's Development Center (SWDC).** A joint venture in Cambodia's Stung Treng province was undertaken with Stung Treng Women's Development Center (SWDC) to reduce poverty by developing village-based sericulture which will enable local farmers to raise silkworms on mulberry trees, harvest and refine silk locally.

This endeavor was commenced through an agreement dated November 10, 2006 with the total funding commitment from the Foundation being \$156,770, \$6,000 of which paid in 2006, \$50,000 paid in 2007, and \$42,170 during 2008, and \$18,320 in 2009. The foundation has also paid \$40,280 during 2010.

Between 2002 and 2010 SWDC has directly supported over 496 women, 685 children and directly assisted many families in the impoverished Stung Treng region of Cambodia. The SWDC programs now include:

Education Program in Literacy and Health
Education Program School Sponsorship
Vocational Training in Traditional Weaving and Sewing
Vocational Training in Carpentry and Building
Vocational training in Sericulture
Support Program in Child Care
Employment at SWDC production center for Mekong Blue
Employment at SWDC café and gallery
Employment at SWDC Sericulture program

Free Lunch Program for workers

The April 2010 agreement with SWDC was funded with \$10,280. The purpose of the April 2010 agreement was to provide a nutritious lunch for all staff at SWDC. Since 2002, SWDC has run its Nutrition program for women to improve their knowledge of health and neutrino for themselves and their families. The Program also provided a nutritious, free lunch for all the workers every day. This has shown to improve their health and vitality for work, reduce illness and sick days and improve safety in the workplace. It also reduces living costs for their families which encourages retention in the workforce. It is a vital component in the sustainability and longevity of SWDC programs because it enables women's long term participation in the workforce. All produce is bought locally and cooked at SWDC by women who have been trained on-site as cooks.

The May 2010 agreement with SWDC was funded with \$20,000. This was to help SWDC obtain financial self-sufficiency through increased awareness and sales of its silk products in the Cambodian and international markets through their Phnom Penh store. The store was set up in 2009. In 2009 Mekong Blue also launched its first online store in the US.

Also during 2010 the foundation funded an internship with \$10,000. This enabled Paul Dent, a graduate student from the Vanderbilt University Owen Graduate School of Management, to travel to SWDC and spend the month of August, 2010 in Cambodia working with the SWDC to assist in project development, oversight, and long-term planning. This was specifically aimed at assisting SWDC to obtain financial self-sufficiency through long-term business planning and strategies for increasing awareness of its silk products, improving production capacity, and enabling the continuation of social development programs.
