

STATEMENT A

The Gerard B. Lambert Foundation is the sole beneficiary of the residuary estate of Robert Isabell who died on July 8, 2009. At the time of his death Mr. Isabell had investments in two commercial real estate properties located at 410-413 West 13th Street and 837 Washington Street in New York City. The titles to the properties were held by Limited Liability Companies ("LLCs") of which Mr. Isabell was a member.

The amount of indebtedness on the properties exceeded \$80 million (with a substantial amount of interest accruing each month) and the appraised value of the properties was approximately \$70 million. The loans from the respective lenders to the LLCs were in default and the other estate assets were exposed to potential liability arising from Mr. Isabell's personal guaranty to one of the lenders, which was subject to a cap of \$7 million. Given this situation, it was entirely possible that the estate's liability under the personal guaranty would wipe out the estate assets, leaving no assets to be distributed to the Foundation.

After conducting their due diligence and taking into account advice from their consultants, the executors of Mr. Isabell's estate decided that their principal objective would be to try to preserve and protect Mr. Isabell's estate assets from liability arising from the personal guaranty. To this end, the executors negotiated a settlement with the lenders that would turn each of the properties over to the lenders in lieu of foreclosure and in exchange for a release from the lenders to the estate from any liability under Mr. Isabell's personal guaranty.

As a result of the settlement, the Foundation received a distribution from the estate of approximately \$1,400,000 in 2010 and is expected to receive an additional distribution of at least \$1,500,000 at the conclusion of the estate administration.
