- A detailed description of the request, including a statement of the need, population to be served, the purpose of the grant, and the timeline for the project, including implementation and completion dates.
- A project budget including the amount requested from the Ridgecliff Foundation and from other sources, the status of those other requests, and the level of in-kind support.
- A detailed description of the specific methods that will be used to evaluate the effectiveness of the project.
- The most recent Annual Report (including financial statements).
