

**Ride Across Indiana (RAIN Ride) - One-way, one-day, 160 mile bicycle crossing of Indiana.**

1,550 Bicyclists from across the country participated in the RAIN 2010 bicycle ride across Indiana. This event encourages bicyclists of all abilities to train and complete a 160 mile one-day timed event on public roads. Publicity about the event makes the general public aware of and serves to advocate and safeguard bicyclists rights to share the public roadways for purposes of recreation and competition.

**Touring Ride In Rural Indiana (TRIRI Rides) - Three week-long bicycle camping or lodging tours which use Indiana State Parks as overnight destinations.** 450 bicyclists from across the country participated in the 2010 TRIRI events. Publicity about the TRIRI events serve to inform the general public about bicycling on public roads. Working with Indiana State Parks, the TRIRI events have resulted in the development of off road bicycle trails on public lands and encourages the use of the bicycle for recreation and for transportation. These major bicycling events help secure public cooperation for periodic major bicycling events promoted under the Club's auspices.
