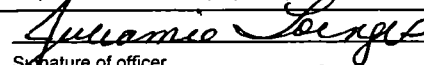

IN THE ZOO'S ANIMAL HOSPITAL, THE STAFF INCLUDES A VETERARIAN, TWO VET TECHS, A HOSPITAL KEEPER, AND AN ANIMAL RECORD KEEPER. THIS IS NECESSARY TO PROVIDE PROPER CARE FOR THE ANIMAL COLLECTION.
