Activities include an annual conference, webinars, newsletter, special projects linking practice with research, and scholarships to students in gerontology Form 990, Part III - Other Program Services Educators and students in Gerontology were supported through two efforts by MGS. In collaboration with the Center on Aging, the newly formed Gerontology Educators Network (GEN) has identified and communicated the programs available for professional development, available on the MGS website. The Network planned activities on Minnesota campuses for an April Careers in Aging Week 2011. Two scholarships were given for students studying for a bachelor's degree and for a master's degree in gerontology. Form 990, Part VI, Line 11b - Organization's Process to Review Form 990 The Form 990 is reviewed by the Treasurer and Executive Director in draft form and then submitted to the Board of Directors for final review and approval. This involves any real or apparent conflict. The Board member does not then participate in deliberations or votes related to that policy.
