The Genevieve Moyer Trust was created by the Last Will and Testament of Genevieve Moyer, deceased. The Will is dated February 14, 1939. The Will created a perpetual Trust for the benefit of two charitable beneficiaries. The assets of the trust consist of a 155 acre farm and the cash necessary to manage the farm. The trustee does not have the authority under the Will to distribute principal to the charitable beneficiaries. The trustee only has the authority to distribute the net income annually, which the trustee has done since the Trust was established over fifty years ago. The charitable beneficiaries have a present and a future interest in the farm. Therefore, the fair market value of the farm must be excluded from determining the minimum investment return and distributable amount in Parts X and XI. Again, the entire net income of the Trust has been distributed to the charitable beneficiaries for over fifty years and will continue to be so distributed in perpetuity.
