- (1) Provide solutions to problems faced by individuals and families who are unable to address their own needs;
- (2) Protect and enhance Michigan's natural environment;
- (3) Improve the availability and quality of education while stressing cost effectiveness;
- (4) Participate in community and civic activities for the betterment of the citizenry and their governments;
- (5) Increase an awareness of the values of artistic and cultural achievements and encourage their growth.

The Foundation considers requests from qualified organizations to support operating budgets and capital fund programs for construction, refurbishment or purchase of buildings, structures, equipment or other physical enhancements. Normally, the Foundation does not contribute to endowments.

A contribution from Consumers Energy Foundation is more likely to be approved when grant seekers' programs are focused on high priority needs, which they are capable of addressing successfully. Indications of capability include an effective governing board; a realistic budget; a clearly defined program that is supported, as appropriate, by the general public, businesses, other foundations and governments; and a record of accomplishment in meeting such needs.

Geographically the principal focus of the Consumers Energy Foundation includes those communities in Michigan's lower peninsula where Consumers Energy has a business presence. Requests are considered from organizations located elsewhere whose programs or projects significantly benefit the State of Michigan and the communities served by Consumers Energy.
