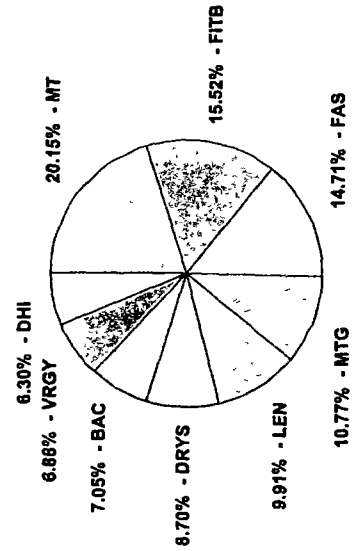
NET ACCOUNT VALUE BY MONTH END




