All applicants must be in the Foundation office by April 1. An Application Cover Sheet, available on the Foundation's website, must accompany each letter of intent along with a one-page project budget summary. The application must be accompanied by the Internal Revenue Service letter of tax exemption. All grants must be paid to 501(c)(3) organizations.
