TRUST IS OPERATED EXCLUSIVELY FOR RELIGIOUS, CHARITABLE, SCIENTIFIC, LITERARY AND EDUCATIONAL PURPOSES WITHIN THE MEANING OF I.R.C. 170(C) AND 501(C). THE TRUST WILL FUND GRANTS TO ORGANIZATIONS WHICH ARE EXEMPT FROM FEDERAL INCOME TAXATION UNDER I.R.C. 501(A) BY VIRTUE OF BEING DESCRIBED IN I.R.C. 501(C)(3) OR TO ORGANIZATIONS CONTRIBUTIONS TO WHICH ARE DEDUCTIBLE UNDER I.R.C. 170 (C)(2), 2055(A) AND 2522(A).
