Statement 2 – Summary of Program Services Accomplishments - \$78,703

The CBO's program service accomplishments for the year 2010 all involve the operation of a building (the "Building") that was constructed in the years 2000 and 2001 as part of a large downtown block development project (the "Downtown Project"). The Downtown Project was developed to attract businesses and people to do business and live in the town, and includes a hotel, business space, restaurant space, and entertainment attractions. The CBO's contribution to the Downtown Project involved the construction and ongoing maintenance and operation of the Building. The Building includes a three-screen movie theater and a restaurant.

a - Depreciation - \$49,644

The depreciation listed on Part IX, Line 22 is for depreciation on the Building.

b - Property Taxes \$28,771

CBO pays the property taxes for the Building. Note, as reported on Part VIII, Line 2a, CBO was reimbursed by tenants for a portion of the property taxes (\$24,738).
