SERVICE BASED MISSION TRIPS ENLIGHTEN PARTICIPANTS TO THE WORK OF JESUS AND STRENGTHEN THEIR FAITH WHILE MAKING A POSITIVE IMPACT ON THE COMMNUNITIES SERVED. THE AMOUNT IS PAID TO THE STUDENT ORGANIZATION THAT IS AWARDED THE SCHOLARSHIP. THE APPLICATIONS ARE REVIEWED BY THE SCHOLARSHIP COMMITTEE (CONSISTING OF KURT WARNER, BRENDA WARNER AND MARCI MORAN) AND THE SCHOLARSHIP RECIPIENTS ARE SELECTED BASED UPON THEIR MEETING THE ABOVE REQUIREMENTS.
