The Foundation primarily limits its interest to the Central and Western United States. Grants generally range from one to ten thousand dollars.

No formal grant application forms are used. However, all requests should be stated in a letter following the guidelines listed below:

### Application Information Required

Proposal letter should include the following:

- 1. Mission statement and background of organization.
- 2. Demonstration of need.
- 3. Amount requested.
- 4 Project title and name of project director
- 5. Purpose of program for which funds are sought.
- 6. Time-lines for program implementation.
- 7. Evaluation after implementation of program.

### Attachments

- 1. Current financial statement
- 2. Copy of tax exempt status
- 3. Roster of Board of Directors
- 4. Optional materials.

### **Submission Date**

Grant applications must be submitted prior to August 31<sup>st</sup>, for consideration at the annual meeting of the Timmons foundation, which is held in October each year. The notification of grant awards will be made as soon as possible after the annual meeting We strive to notify all applicants within 30 days following the annual meeting as to the disposition of their grant request.

### Reports

A status report and evaluation of any funded project should be received by the Foundation either upon completion of the project or not later than March 31<sup>st</sup>, of the following year. This is requested of all grant recipients without regard to the size of the grant. The organization receiving the grant should acknowledge the amount received and states the deposition of the funds. Twenty percent of each Grant in the amount of \$5,000 and more will be withheld until a status report is received.
