- 2. UPON REVIEW OF THE VENDOR LIST AND ANY OTHER POTENTIAL CONFLICTS IDENTIFIED BY THE DIRECTOR OF VOLUNTEER, THE FORM IS COMPLETED AND RETURNED TO ABAG'S PRESIDENT BY THE END OF JUNE OR THE FIRST COMMITTEE MEETING.
- 3. THE OFFICE MANAGER WILL MAINTAIN A MASTER FILE OF ALL FORMS.
- 4. STAFF WILL REVIEW ALL OF THE DISCLOSURE STATEMENTS TO COMPILE A CONFLICT OF INTEREST SUMMARY FOR THE BOARD AND EVERY COMMITTEE. A CONFIDENTIAL COPY SHOULD BE GIVEN TO EACH COMMITTEE CHAIR.

ANY POTENTIAL CONFLICTS WILL BE HANDLED AS PRESCRIBED IN THE CONFLICT OF INTEREST POLICY ADOPTED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS.
