If any Scholarship Funds remain it will be distributed based on seniority in the profit sharing program. In any event, an eligible employee must have at least two years vesting in the profit sharing plan to apply.
- 3. All disbursements will be made payable directly to the educational institution upon receipt of evidence of acceptable academic eligibility and amount of payment due.
