Pursuant to the provisions of W. Va. Code §§ 31E-10-1003 and 31E-10-1005, the undersigned Corporation hereby adopts the following Articles of Amendment to the Articles of Incorporation for such Corporation, <u>FILED IN DUPLICATE</u>:

FIRST: The name of the Corporation is Thomas Memorial Hospital Foundation, Inc.

SECOND: The following amendments to the Articles of Incorporation were adopted by the Board of Directors of the Corporation on September 9, 2010, in the manner prescribed by W. Va. Code § 31E-10-1003:

RESOLVED, that Article I of the Articles of Incorporation of the Corporation be, and it hereby is, amended in its entirety to read as follows:

"I. The name of the Corporation is The Foundation for the Thomas Memorial and Saint Francis Hospitals, Inc. (hereinafter "Corporation")."

RESOLVED FURTHER, that Article III of the Articles of Incorporation of the Corporation be, and it hereby is, amended in its entirety to read as follows:

"III. This Corporation is organized and at all times hereinafter shall be operated exclusively for charitable, scientific, and educational purposes within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended, and the corresponding provisions of any similar law subsequently enacted (hereinafter the "Code"), by supporting, operating for the benefit of, or carrying out the purposes of the Herbert J. Thomas Memorial Hospital Association and Charleston Hospital, Inc. d/b/a Saint Francis Hospital, which are both qualified as tax-exempt organizations under Section 501(c)(3) of the Code (hereinafter the "Association" and "Saint Francis", respectively). If either the Association or Saint Francis ceases to meet the requirements of Section 501(c)(3) of the Code, the Corporation shall be operated

exclusively for the benefit of, to support, or to carry out the purposes of the remaining qualifying tax-exempt organization under Section 501(c)(3) of the Code. If both the Association and Saint Francis cease to meet the requirements of Section 501(c)(3) of the Code, the Corporation shall be operated exclusively for the benefit of, to support, or to carry out the purposes of such other qualifying tax-exempt organization or organizations under Sections 501(c)(3) and 509(a)(1) or 509(a)(2) of the Code as shall be selected by the Board of Directors of the Corporation."

FURTHER RESOLVED, that Article V(a) of the Articles of Incorporation of the Corporation be, and it hereby is, amended in its entirety to read as follows:

"V(a). There shall be no more than thirty-five (35) members of the Board of Directors of the Corporation. A minimum of three (3) of the Directors shall be elected from the membership of the Board of Directors of Thomas Health System, Inc."

RESOLVED FURTHER, that Article V(e) of the Articles of Incorporation of the Corporation be, and it hereby is, amended in its entirety to read as follows:

"V(e). In the event of dissolution of the Corporation, after payment of all necessary expenses thereof, all the remaining assets and property of the Corporation shall be distributed to the Association and Saint Francis as the Board of Directors may determine. If either the Association or Saint Francis ceases to meet the requirements of Section 501(c)(3) of the Code, the remaining assets of the Corporation shall be distributed to the remaining qualifying tax-exempt organization under Section 501(c)(3) of the Code. If both the Association and Saint Francis cease to meet the requirements of Section 501(c)(3) of the Code, the remaining assets of the Corporation shall be distributed consistent with the purposes of this Corporation to such other organization or organizations as then qualify for tax-exempt status under Sections 501(c)(3) and 509(a)(1) or 509(a)(2) of the Code as the Board of Directors may determine."

THIRD: These Articles of Amendment as set forth herein were adopted and approved by the Board of Directors of the Corporation on September 9, 2010, as required under W. Va. Code § 31E-10-1003. The Corporation has no Members.

FOURTH: These Articles of Amendment as set forth herein were adopted and approved

by a vote of a majority of the Board of Directors present at the meeting of the Board at which a quorum was present held on September 9, 2010, as required under W. Va. Code 31E-10-1002. The Corporation has no Members. Accordingly, the approval of these Articles of Amendment set forth herein by the Board of Directors was sufficient for approval in accordance with W. Va. Code §§ 31E-10-1003 and 31E-10-1005.

FIFTH: The undersigned does hereby make and file these Articles of Amendment to the Articles of Incorporation of the Corporation and has accordingly hereto set his hand as of this 9th day of September, 2010.
