	Service removed all federal protections from this Appalachian flying squirrel. The Friends filed a notice letter and brought a lawsuit									
	against the federal government against the Fish and Wildlife Service's delisting. We built a coalition of groups around this effort,									
	did research to assist the lawyers in preparing briefs and tracked actions that could threaten Ginny and her habitat. Oral arguments									
	presented by Jessica Almy were heard in front of Jude Emmett Sullivan on November 17th.
