JOHN W. TRENTON BENEVOLENT TRUST

The John W. Trenton Benevolent Trust (the Trust) is an irrevocable trust created under the will of Dr. John W. Trenton to benefit the citizens of Kingwood and Preston County in the furtherance of community recreation facilities, scholarships, and similar charitable, scientific, literary, and educational purposes. The Trust's funds may be used for the purchase of ground and erection of buildings, for improvements to the land and buildings, equipment, and facilities that will be used to benefit needy and deserving persons and/or projects, as well as enhance existing local charities. These local charities include but are not limited to, projects or undertakings such as Habitat for Humanity or similar charitable scientific, literacy, educational, or benevolent purposes as may be determined and selected by the Board of Trustees, and may further include medical or paramedical scholarships to deserving students from Preston or Grant Counties in West Virginia. The Trust may also be used to help apply for matching grants through governmental agencies and other private foundations. No part of any proceeds of the Trust may be used for political, illegal, or immoral purposes, and funds from the Trust shall not be used in furtherance of projects where the spending and use of Trust funds is directed by governmental agencies or regulations as opposed to the discretion and judgement of the Board of Trustees.

It was Dr. John Trenton's wish to recognize that the people of Preston County provided a place in which he could live and participate in his profession; and in appreciation for that privilege, it was his belief that he could best repay the privilege by supporting organizations and undertakings which are dedicated toward providing their resources unselfishly to the citizens of the County in which he lived.

Annually, the Board of Trustees of the Trust will file with the County Clerk of Preston County, West Virginia, an annual statement showing all receipts and expenditures in detail, together with a statement of all assets in the Trust. It is anticipated that approximately \$8,000 - \$10,000 of funding will be available on an annual basis from the Trust. The current Trustees are Debbie Livengood, David Brown and Pamela Schwer.
