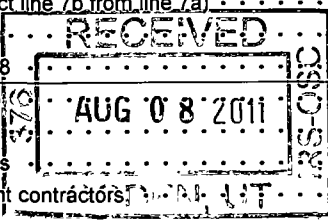

Form 990-EZ, Part III-Organization's Mission Statement & Program Achievement or Accomplishments

Form 990-EZ, Part III-Organization's Mission Statement:

Private, Non-Profit Organization created to develop, foster, promote and protect programs for the welfare of farm people, including their economic, social and educational well-being.

Form 990-EZ, Part III-Organization's Exempt Purposes/Achievements:

In January 2010, Anson County Farm Bureau board of Directors voted unanimously to donate the sum of \$500.00 to the annual 4-H and 4-H Youth Promise Clover Crawl. In the past year, combined program efforts have reached over 1,100 youth in the community through various activities and programs such as school enrichment, summer camps, after school programming, community service and other year round educational programs. Anson 4-H and 4-H Youth Promise also work with adults, volunteer leaders and youth to provide community projects, parenting skills and enhanced leadership abilities. All 4-H programming is available to any youth between ages 5-19. The dollars raised during the Clover Crawl will support programs that address the wellbeing of youth, families and communities in Anson County.

Total Expenditures Contributed to Achievement #1 \$500.00

In February 2010, Anson County Farm Bureau board of Directors approved donating the sum of \$100.00 to the NC Junior Hereford Association for the Southeastern Regional Junior Hereford Show. This show will be held on June 12-13 in Waynesville, NC. This show draws over 100 exhibitors, age 1 to 21 with over 175 cattle from 8 southeastern states. This event teaches responsibility, good sportsmanship and a strong work ethic while providing fun and creating friendships that will stretch across the years and miles.

Also in February the board voted to donate the sum of \$200.00 to the Burnsville Recreation and Learning Center. This center is a non-profit organization that was established in April 1993. This center was birthed out

of the notion to do something great for children of the community. The center offers a Food Pantry that has provided groceries to about 3,500 households in all three counties. The center also has a summer fun program that is offered 5 days a week during the summer for ages 4-17 for 4 hours a day. The children are given breakfast, lunch and dinner everyday. They also participate in activities, field trips and outside physical activities. This program last year fed on average 900 to 1,000 children a day. The center also has an after school program that was establish to motivate good learning skills for children in the community. It is available for children ages 4-12 and is offered 5 days a week from 2:30 to 6:00pm and during this time children are offered a snack and dinner. The center provides a top-notch on site computer lab and computer training for participants of all ages. Adult classes are offered at no cost.

Total Expenditures Contributed to Achievement #2 \$300.00

In April 2010 Anson County Farm Bureau Board of directors approved donating the sum of \$100.00 to the NC FFA Alumni Association silent auction. The Alumni Association is conducting its 9th annual silent auction at the NC FFA Convention on June 22-24 in Raleigh. Proceeds from this auction will be used to support FFA youth development activities in NC.

Also the board of directors voted to approve a donation in the amount of \$200 to the NC Junior Beef Round-Up. This will be the 28th year for this event and it is scheduled for June 5-6 at the NC State Fairgrounds. The NC Junior Beef Round-Up is the second largest event in the state where our 4-H youth can showcase their individual skills and show off their abilities to handle their animals.

Total Expenditures Contributed to Achievement #3 \$300.00

In May 2010, Anson County Farm Bureau awarded 3 scholarships to seniors who were furthering their education either at a college or technical school. These scholarships were for the sum of \$1,000 each and were awarded to their school of choice.

Total Expenditures Contributed to Achievement #4 \$3000.00

In August 2010, Anson County Board of Directors voted to donate the sum of \$3000.00 to the Anson County Extension for the 2010 Anson Ag & Expo & Fair which is to be held in September. The board chose to donate this sum to help with the Farm-City Banquet.

Also in August 2010 the board voted to donate the sum of \$100.00 to the 2010 Tri-County Corn/Soybean Field day held on August 12th. The field day provided the NC Cooperative Extension Service office the ability to demonstrate: Soybean seed treatment evaluations; Soybean Fungicide evaluations; OVT soybean trial; Roundup ready 2 yield plots; conventional soybeans plots; PSNT corn trial; Tri-County Corn Variety trial; as well as offer an opportunity for 2 hours on NCDA & CS pesticide recertification credits.

Total Expenditures Contributed to Achievement #5 \$3,100.00

In September 2010 the AC Farm Bureau board of directors voted to donate the sum of \$500 to Brown Creek Soil & Water Conservation to help with the Farm-City week banquet. The banquet will be held on Sept 21st at the Lockhart Taylor Center. At the banquet awards will be given out along with the Conservation Farm family of the year.

Also the board voted to donate the sum of \$1,000 to the NC Farm Bureau Legal Foundation, Inc. Since 2006, the legal foundation has expended approximately \$134,000 providing needed legal assistance in precedent setting cases affecting NC agriculture. The issues affecting agriculture in NC continue to increase such as water quality, water quantity, farm labor, the impact of regulatory programs, extraterritorial jurisdiction, and many others. The legal foundation has been an important factor in providing legal support for agriculture in precedent setting cases.

Total Expenditures Contributed to Achievement #6 \$1,500.00

In November, 2010 the Anson County Farm Bureau board of directors voted to donate the sum of \$100.00 to the Anson County Cooperative Extension to help with a memorable history book celebrating Extension Home Demonstration work and its history.

In November 2010 the board of directors voted to donate the sum of \$100.00 to Anson County Partnership for Children Barn Blast. Because of the generosity of sponsors, over 900 Anson County children are currently receiving books in the mail each month through the Dolly Parton's Imagination Library.

Also in November the board approved giving a donation of \$200.00 to Peachland-Polkton Elementary School and Anson Middle School. The funds donated to Peachland-Polkton will be used to purchase much needed technology for students to use. The funds donated to Anson Middle School will help with student's medical needs such as band-aids, gloves, tissues, and hand sanitizer.

Also in November the board was ask to help support the new FFA club that was re-establish at Anson High School. The new agricultural teacher Sarah Johnson ask the board of directors to help with purchasing FFA jackets for the officers at a cost of \$500.00. The board of directors voted unanimously that a donation of \$500.00 be made for the jackets.
