Note 1 - Summary of Significant Accounting Policies:

The Foundation

D. F. Halton Foundation, Inc. (the "Foundation") is a non-profit private foundation organized December 10, 1987. The Foundation was established by Pepsi-Cola Bottling Co. of Charlotte, Inc. and Ms. Barksdale F. Halton, the Chairwoman, to provide monetary support to worthy charitable organizations mostly within Mecklenburg County, Gaston County, Iredell County, Lincoln County, and Cabarrus County, North Carolina. Ms. Barksdale F. Halton provides the monetary support for the foundation, as Pepsi-Cola Bottling Co. of Charlotte, Inc. no longer exists as a bottling company.

Basis of accounting

The financial statements of the Foundation are prepared on the basis of fund accounting as described by the American Institute of Certified Public Accountants. This is a procedure by which resources for various purposes are classified for accounting and reporting purposes into funds that are in accordance with activities or objectives specified.

All support and revenue are considered to be available for unrestricted use unless specifically restricted by the donor. Donations are recorded as revenue when received from Ms. Barksdale F. Halton. At its discretion, the Board of Directors of the Foundation may designate funds for specific purposes. Such Board-designated funds are segregated in unrestricted net assets.

Cash flows

For purposes of the statement of cash flows, the Foundation considers all highly liquid debt instruments purchased with a maturity of three months or less to be cash equivalents.

Related parties

In 2010 and 2009, the Foundation received support from the Foundation's president in the amount of \$1,000,000 and \$1,000,000, respectively.

Fair value of financial instruments

The Foundation's financial instruments consist of cash. The carrying amount of this financial instrument approximates fair value.

The Foundation did not have any outstanding derivative instruments at December 31, 2010 or 2009.

Note 1 - Summary of Significant Accounting Policies (continued):

Subsequent events

The Foundation evaluated all events and transactions through November 2, 2011, the date the financial statements were issued. During this period, no material recognizable or non-recognizable subsequent events occurred.

Use of accounting estimates

The preparation of financial statements in conformity with generally accepted accounting principles requires management to make estimates and assumptions that affect the reported amounts of certain assets and liabilities and disclosures. Accordingly, the actual amounts could differ from those estimates. Any adjustments applied to estimated amounts are recognized in the year in which such adjustments are determined.

Note 2 - Commitments:

The Directors of the Foundation had approved, as of December 31, 2010, grants amounting to \$2,155,833. These commitments are scheduled for payment as follows:

Note 3 - Income Taxes:

The Foundation is classified as a private foundation, exempt from income taxes under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, and has obtained exemption letters from federal and state taxing authorities. Accordingly, no provision for income taxes has been made in these financial statements.
