(Revised January 28, 2011)

ARTICLE I Name, Purpose and Principal Office

- Section 1. The name of this organization shall be the AnMed Health Auxiliary (the "Auxiliary").
- Section 2. The Auxiliary is a South Carolina Corporation and is qualified and recognized by the Internal Revenue Service as a tax-exempt organization under the provisions of Section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code and its regulations as amended from time to time.
- Section 3. The principal office and place of business of the Auxiliary shall be located in the City of Anderson, Anderson County, South Carolina.

ARTICLE II Purpose

The purpose of this organization shall be to render service through volunteerism and support of the mission, vision and values to AnMed Health, its affiliates and subsidiaries (hereinafter collectively referred to as "AnMed Health".)

ARTICLE III Membership

- Section 1. Membership in the Auxiliary shall include all AnMed Health volunteers.

 All members shall have the right to vote and participate in business meetings.
- Section 2. There shall be the following types of members:
 - a. <u>Active members</u>: Those volunteers who actively log hours and participate in service programs of the Auxiliary.
 - b. <u>Inactive members</u>: Those volunteers who do not log hours or actively participate in service programs of the Auxiliary. They are entitled to participate in Auxiliary activities for a period of one year from the date they become inactive. At that time, upon notification, they shall have their name removed from the membership roll.
 - c. <u>Honorary Life members</u>: Those volunteers who have been named Honorary Life members by the Auxiliary. Recognition will include

their name being added to the Honorary Life members' plaque which will be prominently displayed at AnMed Health as well as eligibility to participate in all Auxiliary activities for as long as they desire.

ARTICLE IV Officers

- Section 1. The officers of the Auxiliary shall be a President, a First Vice-President, a Second Vice-President, a Recording Secretary, a Corresponding Secretary, and a Treasurer.
- Section 2. In the first year following the adoption of Article IV, "Officers", Section 1, the Auxiliary shall elect a First Vice-President and a Second Vice-President. Each shall serve one year only in his/her respective office. At the conclusion of that first year, the First Vice-President shall assume the office of President for one year only and the Second Vice-President shall assume the office of First Vice-President for one year only. Thereafter, the Auxiliary shall elect every year a Second Vice-President to serve for a period of one year. Persons who have held the office of President are then barred from re-election to the office of Second Vice-President for a period of one year.
- Section 3. All officers other than the President and Vice-President(s) shall be elected to serve for a term of one year and may be re-elected for an additional term of one year in the same office. After election for two successive years to the same office, re-election to that office is barred for the period of one year.
- Section 4. The election of officers shall be held at the regular meeting provided for in Article VII, Section 1.c., infra. or at the discretion of the Board of the Auxiliary, by a mailing to every voting member as defined by Article VII, Section 3., infra.
- Section 5. Should the occasion arise where the First Vice-President is unable to assume the Presidency, the Second Vice-President will be asked to assume the office of President. If neither the First nor Second Vice-President is able to assume the Presidency, the current President may be asked to remain in office for an additional year.

ARTICLE V Duties of Officers

Duties of the President: The President shall be the chief officer of the Auxiliary and of the Board, and shall have the supervision of the general management of the Auxiliary. He/she shall appoint the Chairmen of all standing committees and the Chairmen of such special committees as occasion may demand. He/she shall be a member ex-officio of all standing committees of the Auxiliary except the nominating committee. He/she shall perform all duties incidental to the office of President.

- Duties of the First Vice-President: The First Vice-President shall, in the event of the absence, disability, or resignation of the President, assume the powers and perform the duties of the President. The First Vice-President shall be responsible for coordinating activities designed to maintain the organization and strengthen its capacity to serve, including activities involving Youth Volunteers and recruitment of new members, and shall perform such other duties as may be delegated by the President or the Board of Directors of the Auxiliary.
- Duties of the Second Vice-President: The Second Vice-President shall, in the event of the absence, disability, or resignation of the First Vice-President, assume the powers and perform the duties of the First Vice-President. The Second Vice-President shall be responsible for arranging the annual planning session and two general membership meetings, and shall perform such other duties as may be delegated by the President or the Board of Directors of the Auxiliary.
- Section 4. <u>Duties of the Recording Secretary</u>: The Recording Secretary shall be responsible for keeping records of meetings of the Auxiliary and of the Board in books belonging to the Auxiliary. These records shall be open to inspection by any member at all reasonable times.
- Section 5. <u>Duties of the Corresponding Secretary</u>: The Corresponding Secretary shall give notice of the meetings of the Auxiliary and Board of Directors. He/she shall carry on general correspondence of the Auxiliary and Board of directors.
- Section 6. <u>Duties of the Treasurer</u>: At each regular meeting of the Board of Directors, the Treasurer shall make a statement of the financial condition of the Auxiliary and, at the Annual Meeting of the Auxiliary, shall submit a detailed report of the financial condition of the Auxiliary for the preceding fiscal year. The report shall be reviewed by an accountant designated by the Board of Directors. The Treasurer shall also have access to all of the Auxiliary's financial records and accounts, which are kept in the Volunteer Services office, and make recommendations to the Board as is necessary.
- Section 7. All officers shall at the end of the year file a report with the Recording Secretary.
- Section 8. Consolidation of Offices: In accordance with the provisions of Article XIII, infra, one or more of the offices designated by this Article V may, at the discretion of the Board of Directors of the Auxiliary, be consolidated, except that any one of the four offices of President, First Vice-President, Second Vice-President, and Treasurer may not be consolidated with each other.

ARTICLE VI Board of Directors

Section 1. The Board of Directors of the Auxiliary shall consist of the officers of the Auxiliary, the Chairmen of standing committees, the service chairmen, and the chairmen of such special committees as may be necessary. At the discretion of the Auxiliary President,

no more than two at-large Auxiliary members may be appointed to the Board. The President of AnMed Health or his designee, the Director of Volunteer Services, and the immediate Past-President of the Auxiliary shall be ex-officio members of the Board of Directors.

- <u>/__</u>\
- All actions of the Auxiliary Board are subject to the approval of the AnMed Health governing board with liaison through the AnMed Health President. With the above limitations, management and control of property, funds and affairs of the Auxiliary shall be administered by the Board of Directors on behalf of the Auxiliary membership, which shall have the right of final approval of all matters of Auxiliary policy. Operating policies and procedures necessary to implement the basic policies set forth in the By-Laws and to guide the operations of the Auxiliary shall be recorded in the Administrative Policies and Procedures, a document that may be amended at any time by majority vote of the Board of Directors.
- Regular meetings of the Board shall be held every other month, except as determined by the Board, at such time and place as the Board and/or President may determine. Special meetings of the Board may be held at any time and place when requested in writing by not fewer than five members of the Board.
- Section 4. Six members shall constitute a quorum at any meeting of the Board. In the absence of a quorum, the meeting shall be adjourned.
- Section 5. The President of the Auxiliary shall be empowered to appoint an interim officer, in the case of vacancy in any office, who shall serve until the Auxiliary Board shall by a majority vote appoint a replacement officer for that position to serve that portion of a term not served by an elected officer due to resignation, some other inability to serve or removal from office.

ARTICLE VII Meetings of the Auxiliary

- Section 1. There shall be at least three regular meetings of the Auxiliary membership each year.
 - a. The First meeting of each year, which shall be called the Annual Meeting, shall be for the presentation of the Annual Reports of officers and committees, the installation of new officers, and such other business as may properly come before the membership. This meeting shall also include an educational program.
 - b. The second meeting shall be for the recognition of volunteers by AnMed Health Leadership during National Volunteer Week and such business as may properly come before the membership.
 - c. The third meeting shall be held in the fall for the election of officers, the presentation of Auxiliary awards, and such other business as may properly come

- before the membership and shall be known as the "Fall General Membership Meeting".
- d. The President or his designee shall be empowered from time to time to call special meetings of the Auxiliary membership.
- Section 2. The President and/or the Board may determine the time and place of the meetings.
- Section 3. 35% of members shall constitute a quorum for the transaction of business at any regular or special meeting. The decision of a majority of such quorum who are present shall be binding and conclusive in all matters pertaining to the business of the Auxiliary.

ARTICLE VIII Executive Committee

- Section 1. The Executive Committee shall consist of the President, the First Vice-President, the Second Vice-President, the Recording Secretary, the Corresponding Secretary, and the Treasurer.
- Section 2. The Executive Committee shall be empowered to act for the Board of Directors on all matters properly within the jurisdiction of the Board, which the President determines cannot be held over until the next meeting of the Board.
- Section 3. All actions of the Executive Committee shall be reported to the Board at its next meeting and shall be subject to approval and/or revision by the Board at such a meeting provided that no rights of third parties shall be adversely affected by such revision or alteration.
- Section 4. Meetings of the Executive Committee may be held at any time and place determined by the President. Members of the Executive Committee shall be given not less than 12 hours notice. Notice may be waived if all members sign a waiver either before or after the meeting.

ARTICLE IX Committees and Services

- Section 1. The standing committees of the Auxiliary shall be appointed according to the needs of the Auxiliary. The Director of Volunteer Services shall be an ex-officio member of all these committees.
- Section 2. The President shall appoint the chairman of all standing committees and services in conformity with the By-Laws. These chairmen, upon appointment by the President, shall become members of the Board of Directors.

- Section 3. Each standing committee chairman, in conference with the President, shall appoint a vice-chairman and other members of the committee except as otherwise directed by the By-Laws.
- Section 4. The chairman of each standing committee and service shall be responsible for preparing a summary for the Annual Report.
- Section 5. The President of the Auxiliary may appoint such special committees as he/she may consider necessary to carry out the purposes of the Auxiliary. They shall be automatically dissolved when they have discharged their functions.

ARTICLE X Duties of Standing Committees

Section 1. The Finance Committee

- a. The Finance Committee shall consist of a chairman who is the Auxiliary Treasurer and two additional members.
- b. It shall be the duty of the Finance Committee to keep informed of the financial status of the Auxiliary; to make recommendations to the Board with regard to financial affairs of the Auxiliary; and to review the proposed annual budget for submission to the Auxiliary Board.

Section 2. The Nominating Committee

- a. The Nominating Committee shall consist of three members.
- b. The immediate Past-President of the Auxiliary shall chair the committee and appoint two additional members. If the immediate Past-President is unable or unwilling to serve, the President shall be authorized to appoint another member of the Auxiliary to serve as chairman, with the approval of the Auxiliary officers.
- c. The Nominating Committee will receive nominations for Auxiliary officers from the membership until September 1st. From these suggestions, and as a result of its own deliberations, the Nominating Committee shall submit to the fall general meeting a slate of candidates for the coming year.

Section 3. The Membership Committee

- a. The Membership Committee shall consist of a chairman who is the First Vice-President and two members.
- b. The Membership Committee shall keep an accurate list of the membership. It shall be responsible for recruitment of new members. It shall seek in every way possible

to promote an efficient and active membership in harmony with the purpose of the Auxiliary.

Section 4. The Scholarship Committee

- a. The Scholarship Committee shall consist of a chairman, who is appointed by the President, and not less than four members.
- b. The Scholarship Committee will be responsible for annual reviews and necessary changes to the application process.
- c. The Scholarship Committee will review all applications, interview applicants, and approve applications and renewal requests in accordance with the timeline set forth in the application.

ARTICLE XI Funds

- Section 1. All fund-raising activities shall be subject to the approval of the AnMed Health governing board.
- Section 2. The proceeds of all fund raising shall be expended only for the purposes approved by the AnMed Health governing board and the governing board of the Auxiliary.
- Section 3. All documents made, accepted or executed by the Auxiliary shall be signed by the President or his/her representative.
- Section 4. Checks drawn against funds of the Auxiliary must be signed or countersigned by any two of the following: the President, the Treasurer, one other designated member, or the Director of Volunteer Services.
- Section 5. All Auxiliary monies or funds of any kind shall go through the Auxiliary books. All expenditures of the Auxiliary in excess of \$500.00 must be approved by the Board.

ARTICLE XII Fiscal Year

The fiscal year of the Auxiliary shall commence on January 1 and shall end on December 31 of each calendar year.

ARTICLE XIII Amendments

These By-Laws may be altered, repealed, or amended by the affirmative vote of the members present and voting at any regular or special meeting of the Auxiliary, provided that notice of the proposed alterations, repeal, or amendment is contained in the notice of such meeting, which has been mailed not less than 14 days in advance of the meeting. No amendment shall become effective until approved by the AnMed Health governing board.

ARTICLE XIV Approval
