GRANT POLICIES

1. General

The policies stated below govern the making of grants by The Fickling Family Foundation. The mandatory policies listed below cannot, for legal or other reasons, be varied. Discretionary policies described below may be varied only under rare and specific circumstances, and variance should not be considered as setting a precedent for future grants. The Foundation reserves the right to revise any policy, whether mandatory or discretionary, from time to time as circumstances warrant.

2. Mandatory Policies

- (a) Grants will be made only to organizations that are qualified under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code to receive charitable contributions and that are organizations to which charitable contributions may be made under the provision of Section 170(c) of the Internal Revenue Code as such sections are modified by Section 2055(a) and 2522(a) of the Internal Revenue Code.
- (b) Grants will be made only to such organizations as are described in paragraph (a) above, which furnish documentation satisfactory to the Foundation that they are so qualified.
- (c) Grants will not be made to individuals.
- (d) Grants will not be made to private foundations.
- (e) Recipients of grants will be required to make timely and adequate reports certifying how and when grant funds are expended and what goals were attained as a result of the grant.
- (f) No subsequent grant will be made to a grantee who has failed to comply with the reporting requirements set out in paragraph (e) above.
- (g) All communications to the Foundation must be in writing and addressed to the Foundation.

3. Discretionary Policies

- Priority will be given to the award of grants that will be expended in, and are for the benefit of, Macon and Bibb County, Georgia. The Trustees prefer to make grants only to those organizations having a substantial presence in Bibb County, Georgia. Unsolicited proposals from out-of-state organizations will not be considered. Because of the volume of proposals received, even many worthwhile proposals must be denied. This policy, however, does not preclude the Foundation from initiating requests for proposals where, in the judgment of the Trustees, a qualified prospective grantee performs functions that are deemed particularly worthy of a grant.
- (b) Grants should aid the accomplishment of long-range and lasting purposes.
- (c) Favor will be given to projects that are contingent upon being supplemented by other organizations or individuals.
- (d) No Grant will be made that requires the setting aside of current funds to be paid over a period of years in the future, because such grants require prior approval by the Internal Revenue Service.
- (e) The Foundation reserves the right to attach conditions to grants as circumstances warrant.
- (f) Grant proposals should be submitted by November 1. The Foundation usually meets annually in November or December.

THE MAKING OF GRANT PROPOSALS

Eligibility

Those proposing grants from The Fickling Family Foundation, must be organizations that hold current valid letters of qualification from the Internal Revenue Service evidencing that they are qualified as Section 501(c)(3) organizations and that they are NOT private foundations.

Procedure

Proposers should write the Foundation and request a Proposal For Grant application form. The form should be executed accurately and fully with all required documentation attached. <u>Proposal materials should NOT be bound, stapled, inserted in protective sheets, or prepared in any other types of notebook form</u>. Proposals that do not contain the required information with supporting documentation will be returned without action.

A proposer may choose to provide supplemental information it deems necessary to explain the proposal. However, the proposal form must be filled out completely so that it could stand-alone. Supplemental information may include goals, objectives, activities, evaluation measures, timetables, and budget (the total not to exceed five pages). Voluminous supplemental information is discouraged. If the Foundation desires further information, it will be requested from the organization making the proposal. If a proposal results in a grant, the letter advising the proposer will contain additional conditions as appropriate.

Time Considerations

Proposals for grants may be submitted at any time during the year and are processed (but not necessarily acted upon) in the order in which received. Proposals submitted by November 1 will usually be considered at the meeting held in November or December of each year.

Frequency of Requests

Ordinarily the Foundation prefers not to consider proposals from any organization any more frequently than once every 12 months, whether the results of the previous proposal were positive or negative, or consider proposals from any organization receiving a multi-year grant until all payments have been made.

Information to be included in grant proposals

Please furnish eight (8) sets of the following (unbound and unstapled):

Original and seven (7) copies of Proposal For Grant form fully completed and signed by a responsible officer.

- Project budget accompanied by a budget narrative.
- The organization's annual operating budget.
- Names and affiliations of the members of Board of Directors of Trustees responsible for the management of the requesting organization.
- One copy only of the organization's most recent financial statement.
- One copy only of a current letter of exemption from Federal Income Taxes under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Services Code, including a statement that the organization is not a private foundation (name of proposing organization must be identical with that of the IRS Letter of Qualification).
- One copy only of parts I and IV of schedule A of the organization's two most recent years Form 990.
