Through collection and sale of donated clothing, furniture and household goods, we use approximately 50% of our gross income to support other 501(c)3 charities in their work. We maintain a low expense ratio through the use of 155 volunteer workers. In 2010 Clothes Less Traveled awarded Annual Grants to 17 charitable organizations totaling \$232,300. In addition, 35 other charitable organizations were awarded grants throughout the year on a quarterly granting cycle, totaling \$120,853. Because of the efficient model by which we operate, Clothes Less Traveled has continued each year to maintain our expenses below 50% of net income and have increased sales and proportionally increased grant awards every year since our inception.

A small portion of our profits are used to provide scholarships to local high school seniors who have demonstrated significant contributions to the community through volunteer service hours and who have also maintained high academic standards.
