#### Part III: Statement of Program Services

The USTA Tennessee Tennis Association (TTA) is the state office for the United States Tennis Association (USTA). We are one of nine states that make up the Southern Tennis Association (STA). We have 13,012 members who pay a yearly fee to the USTA and TN receives a small portion of the fees to help run our many programs. Sanction fees (\$2.00 per person) is charged on all our sanction tournaments and this money also goes to help run our programs.

Grants are given out in Tennessee by the USTA and STA and certain grants are matched with our (TTA) funds. Grants are given out to programs such as the National Jr Tennis League (NJTL), USTA Jr Team Tennis programs, USTA Schools programs and USTA Adult league programs, which include mixed doubles, combo doubles, seniors and super seniors. Grants are given to our community tennis associations to help them promote USTA programs in their areas. TN has five major areas that we help supply funds to. Those areas are (1) Memphis, (2) Nashville, (3) Knoxville, (4) Chattanooga, and (5) Upper East. All grants are given on USTA membership/participation involvement and each grant recipient must fill out an accountability form at the end of the year to show how they spent the funds.
